# Shade Trees

# Shade trees enhance the landscape and cool you down in the heat of summer.

#### Royal Red Maple

(Acer platanoides 'Royal Red') Height: 30-40' Spread: 20-30' Full Sun

This extremely hardy variety of maple is highly tolerant of urban conditions. It is adaptable but thrives best in well-drained soil. This tree has attractive, smooth tan bark. Glossy purple foliage turns a magnificent red-orange in fall. This cultivar moderately matures into a broad and dense tree, providing excellent shade for the landscape.

#### **Redpointe Maple**

(Acer rubrum 'Frank Jr.') Height: 45-50' Spread: 25-35' Full Sun

This gorgeous cultivar is a mix between the Red Maple and Autumn Blaze Maple. Its attractive dark green foliage turns a fiery red in fall. It has great adaptability and tolerance of urban sites. Rapid and pyramidal growth forms an appealing shape with a great structure. This variety requires little to no pruning to maintain its neat form.

#### **Bowhall Red Maple**

(Acer rubrum 'Bowhall') Height: 40' Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

This variety of Red Maple has a handsome, broad, and columnar form. The neat symmetry of this tree makes it a very attractive street tree. Green foliage turns spectacular hues of yellow, orange, and red in fall. This specimen thrives best in moist soil conditions when planted in full sun, but is adaptable to many soil conditions. It is tolerant of soil flooding, moderate drought, and urban conditions.

# **Highland Park Maple**

Acer grandidentatum 'Hipazam' Height: 45' Spread: 25' Full Fun

The Highland Park Maple displays a distinctive pyramidal habit. Its dark green foliage turns outstanding hues of red, orange, and yellow in fall. Highly-tolerant of urban pollution, it thrives in city environments or as a street tree. Its broad canopy casts cooling shade onto the landscape.

# Flashfire Sugar Maple

Acer saccharum 'JFS-Caddo2' Height: 45' Spread: 40' Full Sun

Cultivated from Caddo Mountain Sugar Maple seedlings, the Flashfire Maple offers one of the brightest red hues in early fall. Its dark green, dense summer foliage casts cooling shade onto the landscape with its broad canopy. This cultivar has improved mildew resistance and stronger growth.

#### Sugar Maple

(Acer saccharum) Height: 60-75' Spread: 35-40' Sun/ Part Shade

This Midwest native will provide excellent shade and be an eye-catching specimen in the fall. Its vibrant, green foliage changes to brilliant shades of yellow/orange. Its ovate and upright form create a tidy appearance and its moderate growth rate allows it to neatly fill its crown. Sugar Maples are best known for being the primary source of maple syrup by the tapping of their sap.

#### **Green Mountain Sugar Maple**

(Acer saccharum 'Green Mountain') Height: 50-75' Spread: 35-40' Sun/ Part Shade

Upright and ovate, this tree forms a dense crown and casts excellent shade. It will develop good heat and drought tolerance if planted in ideal conditions. Leathery, dark green leaves turn a rich orange/gold in fall. This admirable tree can be enjoyed year-round, especially when tapped for its sap.

#### Autumn Blaze Maple

(Acer x freemanii 'Jeffersred') Height: 40-50' Spread: 30-40' Sun/ Part Shade

The highly popular, award-winning Autumn Blaze Maple is widely appreciated for its stunning appearance. Its upright branching habit and dense canopy form a beautiful shape while providing good shade. Bright green foliage transforms into a long-lasting show of red-orange in fall. Smooth gray bark provides winter interest. Rapidly growing, adaptable, and low maintenance, this hybrid is an ideal specimen for a home, street, or park.

# **Dura Heat River Birch**

(Betula nigra 'BNMTF') Height: 35-40' Spread: 25-30' Sun/ Part Shade

A unique beauty, the Dura Heat River Birch is one of the most adaptable and heat-tolerant birch cultivars. This rapidly growing tree provides interest year-round with its attractive curling bark, open branching habit, and excellent provision of shade. White exfoliating bark reveals smooth, pinkish-tan bark, absolutely captivating in winter. Green foliage changes to a soft yellow in the fall. This tree thrives best in moist soil conditions. It is also highly adaptable to clay soils. An improved version of the native River Birch, it has better resistance to pests and diseases.

#### **Heritage River Birch**

(Betula nigra 'Cully') Height: 40' Spread: 35' Sun/ Part Shade

A fast-growing native tree, the Heritage River Birch holds interest throughout every season. Its open and ovate branching habit gives the tree a graceful and unique form. Textured white peeling bark reveals smooth pinkish-white bark. Green foliage changes to outstanding shades of yellow in fall. This variety is highly adaptable, is bronze birch borer resistant, and has good heat tolerance.

#### Whitespire Birch

(Betula populifolia 'Whitespire') Height: 30' Spread: 15-25' Sun/ Part Shade

A more narrow and columnar variety of birch, the Whitespire Birch makes a good privacy screen when planted in a group. White, chalky, non-peeling bark provides year-round interest. Light green, triangular foliage turns a stunning golden yellow in fall. This tree makes an excellent specimen in any landscape for its attractive shape and coloring.

#### **Renaissance Reflection Birch**

(Betula papyrifera 'Renci') Height: 50-70' Spread: 20-25' Full Sun

This fast-growing Paper Birch cultivar is a tall and graceful specimen that will add elegant appeal to your landscape. Upright branching develops a neat pyramidal crown. Foliage is dark green before transitioning to a warm golden yellow in fall. Striking white bark is adored year-round, especially in winter. This tree is highly adaptable to various soil conditions and is bronze birch borer resistant. Avoid planting this tree in urban environments, as it has low tolerance to pollution.

#### Amber Glow Redwood

Metasequoia glyptostroboides 'WAH-08AG' Height: 30-35' Spread: 20-25' Sun/ Part Shade

Amber Glow has excellent color retention, emerging yellow with hints of burgundy in spring and turning bright yellow in summer. Fall color is a stunning golden amber hue. The attractive pyramidal growth of this specimen brings elegance to the landscape.

#### Dawn Redwood

Metasequoia glyptostroboides Height: 50-70' Spread: 20-30' Sun/ Part Shade

A unique, ancient tree, the Dawn Redwood is the hardiest of the Redwood/Sequoia family. It has a columnar, pyramidal form and is fast-growing. Delicate, needle-like fern leaves turn a stunning coppery-brown color in the fall. Highly textured reddish-brown bark gives this tree even more character. This deciduous conifer is an excellent specimen for large planting sites.

#### Shawnee Brave Bald Cypress

Taxodium distichum 'Shawnee Brave' Height: 50-75' Spread: 15-20' Full Sun

This cultivar of false cypress is more narrow with more dense foliage than others, making it perfect for urban conditions. The fine, medium-green, deciduous foliage provides a soft texture and contrasts wonderfully amongst more coarse textured areas of the landscape.

#### **Bald Cypress**

(Taxodium distichum) Height: 50-70' Spread: 25-35' Sun/ Part Shade

This deciduous conifer is a show-stopper. Its jade-colored, lacy, needle-like leaves turn a coppery red before falling and becoming a rusty-orange mulch to the tree. The Bald Cypress is an incredible substitute for evergreens in wet sites, as they are highly adaptable to wet locations. It also does well in drier, urban sites. Wildlife love this tree.

#### **Triumph Elm**

(Ulmus x <sup>'</sup>Morton Glossy') Height: 50-60' Spread: 30-40' Sun/ Part Shade

The Triumph Elm is a strong, handsome, and quickly establishing tree. Widely adaptable, resistant to elm yellows, having good resistance to the elm leaf beetle, and good DED (dutch elm disease) resistance, this tough cultivar makes an excellent street and shade tree. Sturdy and symmetrical with an ovate form, this Elm takes on a very attractive shape. Dark green foliage changes to a warm golden yellow in fall. Wildlife love this elm.

# **Skyline Honeylocust**

(Gleditsia triacanthos var. inermis 'Skycole') Height: 35-45' Spread: 30-40' Sun/ Part Shade

The Skyline Honeylocust is an adaptable tree that offers dappled shade. This rapidly growing specimen branches into a rounded, spreading form, leafing out later than other trees to protect itself from frost and heavy snow. No raking is necessary for this tree, as it has fern-like leaves. The dark green foliage changes to a brilliant golden yellow in fall. This tree has good urban tolerance and is an ideal street tree.

# American Sentry Linden

(Tilia americana 'McKSentry') Height: 40-50' Spread: 25-30' Full Sun

This native selection is an incredible, adaptable, dense shade tree. It is hardy and has some resistance to the Japanese beetle while being very attractive to pollinators. This moderately-growing tree develops a symmetrical and pyramidal form. In late spring, small, fragrant, yellow flowers decorate the tree. Medium-green, heartshaped leaves turn a warm golden yellow in fall.

#### American Hornbeam

(Carpinus caroliniana) Height & Spread: 20-30' Sun/ Part Shade

Native to the Chicagoland area, the American Hornbeam is a gorgeous specimen for naturalized gardens that wildlife absolutely love. It has an attractive globose form that provides excellent shade. Foliage offers a kaleidoscope of color through the year. New leaves emerge red/purple and mature to deep green. In fall, foliage turns brilliant hues of yellow, orange, and red. This tree is resistant to most pests and diseases.

Birds adore this tree.

#### Native Flame Hornbeam

Carpinus caroliniana 'JFS-KW6' Height: 30' Spread: 20' Sun/ Part Shade

This native and versatile cultivar of hornbeam is bold yet graceful in the landscape. It has a uniform, rounded crown with an upright branching habit. This tree is highly adaptable. It quickly grows into a gorgeous structure that provides excellent shade. Wildlife adore this tree. Medium green foliage turns brilliant red in fall, providing striking contrast. This specimen is an exellent shade tree.

#### American Dream Swamp White Oak

(Quercus bicolor 'JFS-KW12') Height: 50' Spread: 40' Full Sun

The American Dream Swamp White Oak is a highly adaptable shade tree with a broad, pyramidal shape. Its lush density provides excellent shade. This versatile tree can be planted almost anywhere. Enjoy bright, glossy green foliage that turns warm golden yellow in fall. Light brown exfoliating bark reveals smooth gray bark, creating unique interest year-round. Thrives best in wet soil conditions, but tolerates drier soils once established. This oak displays strong resistance to anthracnose and powdery mildew. Use it as a charming shade tree almost anywhere in the landscape.

#### **Bur Oak**

(Quercus macrocarpa) Height & Spread: 70-80' Full Sun

This Midwest native is a charming shade tree that is perfect for large areas. It has an open, irregular branching habit that adds naturalized interest to any landscape. Lustrous, dark green foliage turns yellow and brown in fall. Large acorns attract wildlife. This tree has good adaptability to many soil conditions and tolerates urban conditions.

#### **Urban Pinnacle Bur Oak**

(Quercus macrocarpa 'JFS-KW3') Height: 55' Spread: 25' Sun/ Part Shade

This large shade tree is very adaptable and is heat and drought-tolerant once established. This variety of oak is narrow, upright, and ovate, giving it a handsome composure. Glossy, dark green foliage turns a warm golden yellow in fall. Acorns produced by this cultivar are smaller than other varieties. Wildlife adore this tree.

#### Heritage Oak

(Quercus x mcdanielii 'Clemons') Height: 60-80' Spread: 40-50' Sun/ Part Shade

The Heritage Oak is a large, gorgeous, shade tree. Its ovate, pyramidal form is covered in lush, glossy, dark green foliage that turns a beautiful golden-yellow in the fall. It is slow-growing, extremely adaptable, and very attractive to wildlife. This oak is resistant to leaf tatter, mildew resistant, and develops good cold tolerance. This versatile tree is an excellent street planting option.

#### **Kindred Spirit Oak**

(Quercus robur x bicolor 'Nadler') Height: 30' Spread: 6' Full sun

The Kindred Spirit Oak is a fast-growing hybrid of Swamp Oak and Columnar English Oak. It is extremely lush and charming, as it has a very tightly packed columnar form with a low canopy. Lustrous, dark green foliage turns golden yellow in fall. Its acorns are very attractive to wildlife. This tree shows good resistance to drought and powdery mildew. It is highly versatile and can adapt to various soil conditions. This specimen is also highly tolerant of urban conditions.

#### **Red Oak**

(Quercus rubra) Height & Spread: 60-70' Sun/ Part Shade

This Midwest native is a faster-growing species of oak that matures into a large, handsome, shade tree. Its tolerance of salt and urban conditions makes it a great street tree or planting for more exposed sites. Leaves emerge pinkish-red, changing to dark green, and then eventually a beautiful bronze-red in the fall. With age, it adopts a broad, rounded crown, providing excellent shade.

#### Scarlet Oak

(Quercus coccinea) Height & Spread: 40-75' Full Sun

The Scarlet Oak is a gorgeous tree that is highly adaptable. It tolerates various soil conditions and can be planted almost anywhere that receives full sun. It quickly grows into a magnificent, open structure with a rounded crown. It is somewhat drought-tolerant once established. Deep green, lobed leaves transform into a charming scarlet red in fall, providing dramatic contrast. Its acorns attract various forms of wildlife.

#### Swamp White Oak

(Quercus bicolor) Height: 50-60' Spread: 40-50' Sun/ Part Shade

The Swamp White Oak has stunning character with its textured, scaly, gray-brown bark and glossy, two-toned green foliage. This tree's foliage has brilliant golden-orange fall color. It is widely adaptable, being tolerant of both wet and urban environments. Its rounded, dense form makes it a great shade tree and habitat for wildlife.

#### **Tulip Tree**

(Liriodendron tulipifera) Height: 75-90' Spread: 35-50' Sun/ Part Shade

The Tulip Tree is a rapidly growing, large, dense shade tree. Enjoy tulip-like, greenish-yellow and orange flowers in early summer. Unique bluish-green leaves turn golden yellow in fall. Starting out, it has a pyramidal habit but develops a more ovate form with age. Pollinators and wildlife find this tree very attractive.

#### Little Volunteer Tulip Tree

Liriodendron tulipifera 'Little Volunteer' Height: 35' Spread: 20' Full Sun

This small leafed Tulip tree is a wonderfully compact variety that is an interesting ornamental feature in the landscape. Yellow, cup-shaped flowers are held above the branches from mid-late spring. Emerald green foliage turns outstanding shades of gold and yellow in fall. It is quite intolerant of urban planting sites.

# Niobe Weeping Willow

(Salix alba 'Trisis') Height: 50-70' Spread: 40-60' Full Sun

The fast-growing Golden Weeping Willow is a magnificent, dramatic specimen that provides spectacular interest. It thrives best in wet soil conditions and is highly tolerant of clay soils. Light green, silvery foliage turns golden yellow in fall. Arching branches delicately sweep the ground and give the tree a graceful effect in the landscape.

# Weeping Willow

Salix babylonica Height & Spread: 30-50' Sun/ Part Shade

This elegant specimen will add a dramatic effect to any landscape. Graceful, ground-sweeping branches are decorated with narrow, twotoned foliage. The leaves are medium green with silver undersides, changing to a golden/greenish-yellow in fall. Quickly growing and highly adaptable, the Weeping Willow thrives in waterside settings and moist soil conditions.

#### Autumn Gold Ginkgo

(Ginkgo biloba 'Autumn Gold') Height: 40-50' Spread: 30-40' Sun/ Part Shade

The Autumn Gold Ginkgo is a male, non-seed-bearing cultivar. This variety is very adaptable as well as resistant to most insects and diseases. Unique, light green, fan-shaped leaves transform to a brilliant golden yellow in fall. With age, this tree develops a broad, pyramidal form with an upright and symmetrical habit. This tree is tolerant of urban conditions and low maintenance, making it a great street planting.

#### **Goldspire Ginkgo**

(Ginkgo biloba 'Blagon') Height: 14-16' Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The Goldspire Ginkgo is the perfect choice for adding captivating color to smaller areas in the landscape, as it grows taller than it does wide. It can be planted almost anywhere due to its high adaptability to various climates and soil conditions. Deep green, fan-like foliage turns an attractive shade of golden yellow in fall. Its tall and pyramidal form also makes it an excellent specimen to plant in rows as a privacy screen. Enjoy its minimal maintenance, deer resistance, high drought tolerance, and toughness against pests and diseases.

Fruit trees are excellent resources for both people and wildlife. Try growing your own food and enjoy the fruits of your landscape.

# Kwanzan Cherry

(Prunus serrulata 'Kwanzan') Height: 20-25' Spread: 15-20' Full Sun

The most prolific double-flowering cherry tree, the Kwanzan Cherry is covered in dense clusters of soft pink flowers in early spring. Its eye-catching, effortless elegance is unlike any other. Serrated foliage emeregs coppery-red in spring before maturing to green in summer. Fall color is a stunning golden/bronze. Its open and upright branching habit brings a very delicate presence to the landscape. It thrives in various conditions and can be planted almost anywhere.

# **Pink Showers Weeping Cherry**

(Prunus x 'Pisnishzam') Height: 35' Spread: 25-30' Full Sun

Elegant, arching branches are cloaked with delicate pink flowers in early spring, standing out against the silvery gray branches. Serrated, dark green foliage has no issue with Shot Hole disease and turns red-orange tones in fall. This vigorous grower quickly develops into a dramatic specimen. This large, elegant tree is sure to bring unique interest to the landscape.

# **Snow Fountains Weeping Cherry Tree**

(Prunus x 'Snofozam') Height: 8-15' Spread: 6-12' Full Sun

Naturally weeping, dramatic branches are covered with showy, snow white flowers in early spring. This tree is a magnificent, compact, and hardy specimen. Very few red-black ornamental fruit appear in summer and are attractive to wildlife. This specimen is very disease and insect resistant. Lush, glossy green leaves emerge after flowering. Fall foliage colors are hues of vibrant orange and gold. This tree's mahogany trunk stands out against snow in winter and provides interest throughout the seasons.

# Spring Wonder Sargent Cherry

(Prunus sargentii 'Hokkaido Normandale') Height: 25' Spread: 20' Full Sun

This magnificent flowering cherry tree is the hardiest variety out there. Large clusters of showy pink flowers emerge in early spring before the leaves. New foliage emerges purple before turning dark green. Fall color is a bold brick red. The fruits are showy black drupes displayed in mid summer. The smooth red bark adds interesting dimension to the landscape. Wildlife highly adore this tree.

# Adirondack Crabapple

(Malus 'Adirondack') Height: 15-18' Spread: 6-8' Full Sun

The spectacular Adirondack Crabapple is one of the most profusely flowering cultivars of crabapples. Its smaller form makes it an excellent choice for smaller planting sites. White and pink blossoms are abundant and fragrant in spring. Red-orange fruit follows in fall and lasts well into winter. Medium green foliage yellows in fall. This cultivar is highly disease resistant and performs best in full sun.

# **Coralburst Crabapple**

(Malus 'Coralburst') Height & Spread: 10' Sun/ Part Shade

A small, rounded specimen, the Coralburst Crabapple is the perfect tree to provide long seasonal interest in your landscape while not filling in too much space. Coral-pink buds produce semi-double rosepink flowers in spring. Orange-red fruit follows and persists into late fall. Tiny green leaves are yellow in fall. This cultivar is very hardy and disease resistant.

# **Firebird Crabapple**

(Malus sargentii 'Firebird') Height: 8' Spread: 10' Sun/ Part Shade

This dwarf variety of Crabapple puts on a charming show that is enjoyed through the seasons. Fragrant white flower clusters bloom in spring, attracting pollinators. Long-lasting red fruit follows and remains on the tree through winter. Wildlife enjoy the bright red fruit until it drops in the spring. Green foliage turns yellow and bronze in fall. This tree performs best in full sun.

# **Red Jewel Crabapple**

(Malus 'Jewel Cole') Height 15' Spread: 12' Full Sun

The Red Jewel crabapple is the most profuse and persistent crabapple cultivar in producing its bright red fruits. It produces an abundance of fragrant white flowers in spring before brilliant fruit emerges in fall and remains through winter. Dark green foliage turns yellow in fall. This tree shows good disease resistance and fits beautifully into smaller spaces.

# **Rejoice Crabapple**

(Malus 'Rejzam') Height: 12-15' Spread: 8-10' Full Sun

This naturally symmetrical tree has a tidy and upright form that is low-maintenance. It produces rosy-pink flowers in spring before producing burgundy fruits that invite wildlife. The Rejoice Crabapple bears less fruit than other crabapples, leaving minimal mess. Dark green foliage has beautiful burgundy variegation and transforms to golden yellow in fall. This tree displays good disease resistance.

# **Royal Raindrops Crabapple**

(Malus 'Royal Raindrops') Height: 15-20' Spread: 12-15' Sun/ Part Shade

This adaptable specimen will surely add stunning appeal to your landscape. Deep pink blooms that emerge in spring are followed by red-purple fruits that persist through winter. Unique foliage is wine-red before becoming a deep burgundy in summer. Fall color is a vibrant red-orange. This variety of crabapple is heat and drought-tolerant once established. It also has great disease resistance.

# Ruby Dayze Crabapple

(Malus 'KW139MX') Height: 22' Spread: 16' Full Sun

This attractive purple-leaved crabapple variety is tightly branched, upright, and ovate. Bright magenta-pink flowers, and bold redorange fall color are stand-out features that provide charming interest in the landscape. This is one of the most disease-resistant purple-leaved crabapple varieties available. Fall fruits are deep red and persistent into winter. Wildlife absolutely adore this tree.

# Sargent Tina Crabapple

(Malus sargentii 'Tina') Height: 4-5' Spread: 5-6' Full Sun

Excellent for smaller landscapes, this dwarf variety of crabapple has a horizontal, irregular branching habit. Showy flowers in spring are white and fragrant. Small bright red fruit follows in fall and attracts wildlife. Green foliage turns yellow in fall. This tree is a unique beauty as well as adaptable, resistant to disease, and droughttolerant once established.

# Sugar Tyme Crabapple

(Malus 'Sutyzam') Height: 18' Spread: 15' Full Sun

This magnificent specimen produces large, showy blossoms in spring. Their fragrance can be enjoyed if planted near a porch or patio. Shiny red fruit emerges after flowering and is enjoyed by wildlife as it persists through winter. Dark green foliage turns a brilliant golden yellow. This tree displays good disease resistance.

# Show Time Crabapple

(Malus 'Shotizam') Height: 20-25' Spread: 15-20' Sun/ Part Shade

The sturdy and upright branches of the Show Time Crabapple are covered in densely clustered fuschia pink flowers in spring. Dark green foliage turns brilliant shades of orange and red in fall. Cherry-red fruits are enjoyed by wildlife in fall and persist through winter. This variety of crabapple is very winter-hardy, low-maintenance, and has great disease resistance.

# **Starlite Crabapple**

(Malus 'Jeflite') Height: 20-25' Spread: 15-20' Full Sun

The Starlite Crabapple creates a spectacular visual through the seasons. Snow-white, clustered blooms emerge in spring and invite pollinators. Flowers are followed by long-lasting, candy-apple-red fruit in fall. Dark green foliage transforms into an outstanding yellow in fall. This variety of crabapple is highly tolerant of urban conditions.

# **Gladiator Crabapple**

Malus x astringens 'Durelo' Height: 20' Spread: 9' Full Sun

This excellent ornamental tree displays a profusion of bright pink flowers followed by small red-purple fruit. Dark and glossy bronzepurple foliage is highly disease resistant. The smaller stature of this tree makes it ideal for more space-challenged sites.

#### Ivory Spear Crabapple

Malus 'JFS KW 214MX' Height: 18' Width: 7' Full Sun

Dark green foliage covers the tightly columnar form of this tree, disease-free, all season. Fall color is bronze yellow. Deep pink buds reveal an abundance of white blooms before producing bright red fruits that persist into winter to be enjoyed by birds. Pollinators also love this tree.

#### **Raspberry Spear Crabapple**

Malus 'JFS KW 213MX' Height: 20' Width: 8' Full Sun

Dark purple foliage covers the upright, columnar form of this tree, disease-free, all season. Fall color is rusty orange. Deep pink buds give way to bright magenta blooms that produce purple-red fruits that persist into winter to be enjoyed by birds. Pollinators also love this tree.

# Limelight Hydrangea Tree Form

(Hydrangea paniculata 'Limelight') Height: 6-8' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

The Limelight Hydrangea's white blooms age to an array of pink, red, and burgundy which persists through frost for months of irresistible flowers. The flower heads emerge on new wood and pack the branches, filling in like a lush bouquet. It also makes an excellent cut flower, fresh or dried. This variety is both cold hardy and drought-tolerant once established. Use this petite specimen almost anywhere in your landscape.

# Little Quick Fire Hydrangea Tree Form

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMHPLQF') Height & Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Little Quick Fire Hydrangea is an eye-catching specimen. Flowers emerge on new wood in late May or early June. The flowers turn a marvelous deep pink with age. Its gorgeous flower heads make stunning cut-flowers for arrangements. This variety is rarely to never fed on by Japanese beetles. Once established, it is droughttolerant.

#### Pinky Winky Hydrangea Tree Form

(Hydrangea paniculata 'DVPinky') Height: 6-10' Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The amazing flowers on this hardy hydrangea are uniquely colored. Large bloom clusters emerge white on new wood in summer and deepen to rosy pink while the top remains white. This two-toned look gives this tree an element of excitement and flare. The phenomenal colors and tree form shape are truly a lovely sight. Flowers last well into fall and are perfect for cut flower arrangements.

# **Quick Fire Hydrangea Tree Form**

(Hydrangea paniculata 'Bulk') Height: 8-10' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Quick Fire Hydrangea is one of the first of the paniculata hydrangea cultivars to bloom in the summer, blooming on new wood a month sooner than others. Its flowers are white and mature to a bright pink-red color that is retained until the fall. Its flower heads are perfect for cut-flower arrangements. This variety is highly tolerant of urban conditions. Use this gorgeous specimen almost anywhere in the landscape.

# Fire Light Hydrangea Tree Form

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMHPFL') Height & Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The cold hardy and durable Fire Light Hydrangea is a show-stopping specimen that provides brilliant interest, especially in its tree-form. It is widely adaptable and can be planted almost anywhere in the landscape. Large, full, white flowers emerge in early summer on new wood. They transform to pink and deepen to a pomegranate-red color towards the end of summer. This tree has thick stems that hold its flower heads upright, allowing you to enjoy their full beauty. Enjoy the stunning blooms both in the landscape and as cut accents in arrangements.

#### **Dwarf Korean Lilac Tree Form**

(Syringa meyeri 'Palabin') Height: 5-7' Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

The Dwarf Korean Lilac tree is a finely textured specimen. Blooms are highly fragrant and pale in color. This lilac is covered in stunning panicles of fragrant flowers at the ends of the branches in late spring. This variety blooms a bit later than French hybrid lilacs, extending your spring enjoyment by weeks. Plant this widely adaptable tree almost anywhere in the landscape.

# Ivory Silk Lilac Tree Form

(Syringa reticulata 'Ivory Silk') Height: 15-25' Spread: 10-15' Full Sun

This tree will make a significant impact in your landscape. It produces foot-long flower panicles in late June. After other lilacs have finished blooming, this tree continues to flower. Creamy white, fragrant flowers appear in early summer. Once the blooms have finished, enjoy the shade from the Ivory Silk's large green leaves. Attractive brown bark also adds some texture and dimension to the winter landscape.

# **Beijing Gold Japanese Tree Lilac**

(Syringa pekinensis 'Zhang Zhiming') Height: 15-20' Spread: 10-15' Full Sun

The Beijing Gold Japanese Lilac is a tree of graceful, upright habit with multiple seasons of interest. In early summer, a profusion of fragrant heads of tiny yellow flowers cover the tree in clusters. The blossoms give way to green fruits that turn a nice tan color and persist well into the winter months. The erect branches are covered in deep green, semi-glossy leaves that turn golden-yellow in fall. Enjoy its cinnamon-colored exfoliating bark in winter. Tolerant of drought, extreme cold, and salt, this is a tough and magnificent specimen.

#### **Snowdance Japanese Tree Lilac**

(Syringa reticulata 'Snowdance') Height: 15-20' Spread: 15-18' Full Sun

Noted for its heavy blooms, this lilac is a marvelous specimen with an ovate/round crown. In early summer, huge clusters packed with fragrant, tiny, creamy-white flowers adorn the tree. The blossoms give way to loose clusters of tan capsules that persist well into the winter months. The erect branches are clothed in lustrous, dark green leaves in summer. Equally handsome is the shiny, reddish-brown exfoliating bark with horizontal lenticels, reminiscent of cherry bark. Drought-resistant and free of pests and disease, this lilac is easily cared for.

# Dark Purple Bloomerang Lilac Tree Form

(Syringa x 'Penda') Height: 5-7' Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

Enjoy months of blooms instead of just weeks with the Dark Purple Bloomerang Lilac. Naturally growing a handsome, rounded crown, very large dark purple buds emerge in mid to late spring. These open to a deep purple-lilac color and perfume the air for weeks. The shrub takes a brief rest to create new growth before it starts to bloom again in mid to late summer, continuing through frost. It is also noted for its exceptional disease resistance. It is sun-loving, deer resistant, and easily cared for.

#### Pagoda Dogwood

(Cornus alternifolia) Height & Spread: 15-25' Sun/ Part Shade

The Pagoda Dogwood is a gorgeous ornamental feature for the landscape. Its tiered, horizontal branching habit gives the appearance of a Japanese Pagoda. Fragrant, creamy-white flowers cover its branches in spring. Dark green foliage turns a magnificent burgundy in fall. Bluish-black fruits in mid-summer with orangishred stems attract various forms of wildlife. This dogwood is virtually pest and disease-free.

# **Golden Glory Cornelian Cherry Dogwood**

(Cornus mas 'Golden Glory') Height: 20' Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

The Golden Glory Cornelian Cherry Dogwood has clusters of yellow flowers along the branches from late winter to early spring before the leaves emerge. It has dark green deciduous foliage with no appreciable fall color. It produces red berries from early to mid-summer that are enjoyed by birds. The peeling brown bark adds an interesting dimension and texture to the landscape. This dogwood is low-maintenance and highly adaptable.

#### Kousa Dogwood

Cornus kousa Height & Spread: 15-25' Sun/ Part Shade

This small native tree blooms weeks later than other Dogwoods. Its graceful form is truly a statement in the landscape. Small white flower clusters contrast the green foliage for up to a month of display. Red berries follow these flowers and are adored by birds. Fall hues are marvelous shades of red-purple.

# **Black Pearl Redbud**

Cercis canadensis 'Jn16' Height: 15-20' Spread: 20-25' Sun/ Part Shade

This striking Redbud profusely blooms lavender-pink flowers on its bare branches for several weeks in spring. This native species is draped in a dramatic display of dark purple, heart-shaped foliage before it turns hues of chartreuse in fall. Wildlife love this tree and it is deer-resistant. It makes an excellent focal point in the landscape.

#### Midnight Express Redbud

Cercis canadensis 'Midnight Express' Height: 20' Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

A profusion of bright pink blooms lasts several weeks in spring. Lime green, heart-shaped summer foliage transforms to a velvety burgundy before taking on yellow hues in fall. This tree is highly tolerant of urban conditions. Deer do not tend to care for this specimen.

#### **Eastern Redbud**

(Cercis canadensis) Height: 25' Spread: 30' Sun/ Part Shade

A widely adored favorite, the Eastern Redbud is the perfect specimen to add graceful detail to any landscape. Rosy purple blooms in spring cover its bare branches. Heart-shaped foliage soon follows, emerging green and becoming a soft yellow in fall. This specimen is very attractive to wildlife such as birds and pollinators.

#### Flame Thrower Redbud

(Cercis canadensis 'NC2016-2') Height: 15-20' Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

The Flame Thrower Redbud creates a stunning, colorful display and provides spectacular contrast in all landscapes. Light pink flowers emerge in spring and are followed by a dynamic display of colorful foliage. Leaves emerge burgundy red, yellow with age, and mature to medium green. Enjoy the beautiful blending of colors as the tree puts on its spectacular show.

#### Lavender Twist Redbud

(Cercis canadensis 'Covey') Height: 5-6' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

In early spring, lavender-pink flowers decorate the slightly contorted branches that weep down the Lavender Twist Redbud. Green heart-shaped foliage emerges after flowering. This specimen is very attractive year-round. Even when bare, you can enjoy its interesting architecture. Being a smaller variety of Redbud, it can be easily placed almost anywhere in a landscape to enjoy its beauty.

# Ann Magnolia

(Magnolia x 'Ann') Height & Spread: 10' Sun/ Part Shade

This dramatic tree is a gorgeous flowering specimen. Rosy pink blooms emerge in spring and are slightly fragrant. If conditions are adequate, this tree will sporadically bloom through summer. Green foliage turns golden yellow in fall. Ideal planting sites for magnolia are sheltered areas that are not exposed to cold/ dry winds. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

#### **Galaxy Magnolia**

(Magnolia x 'Galaxy') Height: 20-30' Spread: 10-15' Sun/ Part Shade

The award-winning Galaxy Magnolia is a magnificent specimen with large dark pink blossoms. Its leaves are large and oval-shaped, starting off green and turning a warm bronze in fall. This tree's attractive form is round and upright. Ideal planting sites for magnolia are sheltered areas that are not exposed to cold/ dry winds. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

#### Genie Magnolia

(Magnolia x 'Genie') Height: 10-13' Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The Genie Magnolia is an elegant columnar specimen. Fragrant, deep-pink flowers bloom mid-spring. Upright and open branching gives this tree a charming appearance. If conditions are adequate, this tree will sporadically bloom through summer. Green foliage turns yellow in fall. It is a great focal point to plant near a patio where its fragrance and beauty can be enjoyed. Ideal planting sites for magnolia are sheltered areas that are not exposed to cold/ dry winds. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

# Jane Magnolia

(Magnolia liliflora 'Reflorescens' x stellate 'Waterlily') Height: 10-15' Spread: 8-12' Sun/ Part Shade

The Jane Magnolia has an attractive, rounded form and its relatively coarse texture makes it stand out in the landscape. It is draped in stunning, fragrant, burgundy, cup-shaped flowers with a white reverse held atop the branches in mid spring before the leaves emerge. It has dark green foliage. The large pointy leaves turn coppery-bronze in fall. Ideal planting sites for magnolia are sheltered areas that are not exposed to cold/ dry winds. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

#### Leonard Messel Magnolia

(Magnolia x loebneri 'Leonard Messel') Height: 10-20' Spread: 10-18' Sun/ Part Shade

This compact variety of magnolia is less susceptible to late frosts than other types. Two-toned white and pink flowers have a star-like appearance. Green foliage turns bronze in fall. Enjoy the sweet fragrance and spectacular show of its flowers by planting this tree near a porch or patio. Ideal planting sites for magnolia are sheltered areas that are not exposed to cold/ dry winds. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

#### **Royal Star Magnolia**

(Magnolia stellata 'Royal Star') Height: 10-15' Spread: 10-12' Sun/ Part Shade

The Royal Star Magnolia is a small accent tree ideal for smaller landscapes. Snow-white flowers emerge in early spring. Dark green foliage turns a coppery-bronze in fall. Its compact and upright form is tidy without pruning. Ideal planting sites for Magnolia are sheltered areas that are not exposed to cold/ dry winds. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

#### **Sunsation Magnolia**

Magnolia x Sunsation Height: 20-25' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

Brighten your landscape with this stunning Magnolia hybrid. Masses of upright, golden yellow flowers with a rosy base bloom mid-late spring on bare branches. Dark green leaves follow these blooms and turn bright yellow in fall. This gorgeous specimen makes a lovely focal point in the landscape.

#### Lil Kim Red Rose of Sharon

Hibiscus syriacus 'SHIMRR38' Height & Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

This new addition to the 'Lil Kim' series has a smaller, compact habit, easily fitting into the landscape. Deep rosy red blooms contrast beautifully among its dark green foliage and attract pollinators. This tough, reliable, deer-resistant shrub requires little to no maintenance.

#### Aphrodite Rose of Sharon

Hibiscus syriacus 'Aphrodite' Height: 6-10' Spread: 6-8' Full Sun

A compact, medium-sized shrub, this Rose of Sharon's semi-upright growth habit and neat form make it a great hedge. Ruffled pink flowers are around 4" in diameter and add a lovely pop of color while attracting pollinators. This tough, deer-resistant shrub requires little to no maintenance.

#### Purple Pillar Rose of Sharon

Hibiscus syriacus 'Gandini Santiago' Height: 10-16' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

A very unique Rose of Sharon, Purple Pillar naturally grows as a column rather than spreading. In summer, each stem is covered in gorgeous purple blooms. This stunning, deer-resistant, space-saver can be used to create a privacy screen or hedge. Pollinators love this plant.

#### White Chiffon Rose of Sharon

Hibiscus syriacus 'Notwoodtwo' Height: 8-12' Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

Crisp white flowers are extra showy among this specimen's dark green foliage. It is an award winning shrub with a rounded habit, constructed with soft, graceful stems. The ease of care and toughness of this specimen are unbeatable. This stunning, deer-resistant shrub can be used to create a privacy screen or hedge. Pollinators are very attracted to this plant.

#### White Pillar Rose of Sharon

Hibiscus syriacus 'Gandini van Aart' Height: 10-16' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

A sister plant to 'Purple Pillar', White Pillar naturally grows as a narrow column. This variety displays pure white, semi-double blooms, adding elegance to the landscape. Its unusual space-saving habit brings new design possibilities to light. This reliable and adaptable plant is deer-resistant and low-maintenance.

#### **Blue Satin Rose of Sharon Tree Form**

(Hibiscus syriacus 'Marina') Height: 8-10' Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

This long-blooming, reliable, easy care plant will bloom all summer long. It offers a true blue flower and produces few to no seeds. Blooming continuously from late summer to fall, each flower lasts about one day and stands out against the ovate green foliage. Hummingbirds and other pollinators absolutely love this specimen. It is deer and drought resistant.

#### Lavender Chiffon Rose of Sharon Tree Form

(Hibiscus syriacus 'Notwoodone') Height: 6-8' Spread: 6' Full Sun

The Award-winning Lavender Chiffon Rose of Sharon is a stunning specimen noted for its large, lilac-pink, double flowers, adorned with darker veins at their center. Blooming continuously from late summer to fall, each flower lasts about one day and stands out against the ovate green foliage. Hummingbirds and other pollinators absolutely love this specimen. It is deer and drought-resistant.

#### Woodbridge Rose of Sharon Tree Form

(Hibiscus syriacus 'Woodbridge') Height: 10' Spread: 5' Full Sun

The Woodbridge Rose of Sharon is valued for large, rosy-pink flowers produced in summer. It makes an attractive, small specimen tree. The contrasting color brings exceptional interest to the landscape. Blooming continuously from late summer to fall, each flower lasts about one day and stands out against the ovate green foliage. Hummingbirds and other pollinators absolutely love this specimen. It is deer and drought-resistant.

# **Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry**

(Amelanchier grandiflora 'Autumn Brilliance') Height: 20-25' Spread: 15-20' Sun/ Part Shade

This native tree is adored by both people and wildlife for its delicious edible berries. Pinkish-white buds produce an abundance of showy white flowers in spring. Its flowers are followed by fruit

of showy white flowers in spring. Its flowers are followed by fruit that looks similar to a blueberry. Green foliage turns a bright red-orange in fall. Enjoy this tree as a stunning, flowering focal point. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

# **Robin Hill Serviceberry**

(Amelanchier grandiflora 'Robin Hill') Height: 20' Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

This native tree is adored by both people and wildlife for its delicious edible berries. This smaller, more upright, variety of Serviceberry has pretty pinkish-white blooms that are followed by small blueberry-like berries. Green foliage turns to redorange in fall. Enjoy this smaller tree as a stunning, flowering focal point. Deer tend to not care for this tree.

#### Spring Flurry Serviceberry

(Amelanchier laevis 'JFS-Arb') Height: 28' Spread: 20' Sun/ Part Shade

This native tree is adored by both people and wildlife for its delicious edible berries. A small tree with clear white spring blooms and attractive orange fall foliage, it is a spectacular specimen. Its good branching structure and habit make this an excellent street tree or lawn specimen. This tree adds a delicate, fine texture to the landscape.

### **Cumulus Allegheny Serviceberry**

Amelanchier laevis 'Cumulus' Height: 10' Spread: 8' Sun/ Part Shade

Delicate white blooms cover this tree's bare branches in early spring, producing purple-black berries that are edible to both humans and wildlife. Green foliage emerges after flowering and turns into a kaleidoscope of red, orange in yellow in fall. It makes a wonderful, small specimen tree with multi-season interest. Birds and pollinators love this tree.

#### **Tianshan Seven Son Flower Tree**

(Heptacodium miconioides 'MINHEP') Height: 8-12' Spread: 5-7' Full Sun

It is small, rounded, upright with dark green leaves and clusters of creamy white flowers in late summer which attract butterflies, bees and other beneficial pollinators. Flowers are followed by unusual purple-red fruit. It has attractive yellow fall color and exfoliating bark in winter. Deer do not care for this plant.

#### **Paperbark Maple**

(Acer griseum) Height: 25' Spread: 15-20' Sun/ Part Shade

A unique specimen with a handsome appearance, the Paperbark Maple holds seasonal interest year-round. It has an upright and open branching habit, distinguishing this cultivar from other maples. Its coppery paper bark peels back to reveal smooth cinnamon-brown bark. Soft green foliage turns a stunning scarlet red in fall. The spectacular form of this tree is sure to stand out in any landscape.

# Mohican Viburnum

Viburnum lantana 'Mohican' Height: 7-8' Spread: 7-20' Sun/ Part Shade

An excellent border/ hedging shrub, the Mohican Viburnum is a dense and compact cultivar. It produces creamy white flower clusters in late spring, followed by red berries that mature to black. Birds adore these fruits. Pollinators also love its flowers. This plant is somewhat deerresistant.

#### **Blackhaw Viburnum**

(Viburnum prunifolium) Height: 12-15' Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

Native to the Chicagoland area, the Blackhaw Viburnum is a large shrub or small tree. It tolerates various soil types as long as it has good drainage. In spring, new leaves emerge copper-orange followed by white, flat-topped flowers. In fall, black fruits contrast with the pinkish-red foliage and are enjoyed by wildlife. This is a great plant for naturalized areas as it is durable and pest-free.

#### Forest Rouge Blackhaw Viburnum

(Viburnum prunifolium 'McKRouge') Height: 10-12' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

This selection gets its name from its outstanding maroon fall color, which holds for up to a month whether planted in sun or shadier spots. It is a more ovate variety of Viburnum that exhibits dense, upright branching. Young stems are dark red, contrasting nicely with the yellow-green foliage of spring. Clusters of creamy white flowers bloom in spring as the leaves begin to turn dark green. Bluish-black berries persist into winter, attracting wildlife. It performs best in moist, welldrained soil.

# Nishiki Dappled Willow Tree

(Salix integra 'Hakuro Nishiki') Height & Spread: 15-20' Sun/ Part Shade

Attracting the eye with its bright, showy colors, the Dappled Willow is a deciduous shrub or small tree of great beauty. Luminous variegated foliage on graceful branches is adored. Emerging pink in spring, the narrow leaves gradually mature to variegated shades of pink, creamy-white and green, before fading to green as the summer progresses. In the fall, the leaves turn yellow before revealing coral red stems to enjoy in winter.

#### **Common Witch Hazel**

(Hamamelis virginiana) Height: 15-20' Spread: 10-15' Sun/ Part Shade

This plant can be a small tree or tall shrub. Large, spreading branches form an irregular, open crown. Its fragrant, unique, yellow flowers with crumpled petals appear in the fall and persist into winter. Green leaves turn brilliant gold in fall. Fruit capsules mature a year after flowering and expel seeds that attract birds. This specimen is tolerant of road salt and clay soil. This is a great deer-resistant specimen for a naturalized landscape.

### **Diane Witch Hazel**

(Hamamelis x intermedia 'Diane') Height & Spread: 8-12' Sun/ Part Shade

The best red-flowered Witch Hazel, it is a large deciduous shrub of open and spreading habit. Hardy, this winter-flowering shrub produces dense clusters of slightly scented, red to copper-red flowers in mid and late winter. Each flower consists of 4 ribbon-like, crinkled, star-shaped petals with claret bases and a purple-red calyx. The broadly oval, green leaves turn attractive shades of yellow, orange, and red in fall. This is a great deer-resistant specimen for a naturalized landscape.

# Vernal Witchhazel

(Hamamelis vernalis) Height & Spread: 8' Sun/ Part Shade

Vernal Witchhazel is a great looking, durable, native tree that is a great addition to any yard. The large medium green leaves turn a beautiful golden yellow in late fall. This plant also features long-lasting, fragrant, yellow to red flowers which have an interesting shape and appear between January and March, providing some color to the otherwise bleak landscape.

# **Royal Frost Birch**

(Betula x 'Royal Frost') Height: 40' Spread 25' Sun/ Part Shade

A colorful and contrasting specimen, the Royal Frost River Birch stands out beautifully in any landscape. Sleek white bark contrasts with rich dark green foliage that turns dark red in fall. It adopts a pyramidal growth habit with age and develops good drought tolerance once established.

### **Red Obelisk Beech**

(Fagus sylvaticas 'Red Obelisk') Height: 40' Spread: 3-5' Full Sun

A very narrowly formed beech, its upright and compact growth creates a stunning focal point. The columnar habit of this tree makes it excellent for creating a privacy screen. Glossy dark red/purple foliage turns reddish brown in fall, providing contrast through the seasons. This tree is an excellent low-maintenance accent that will add gorgeous color to your landscape.

# **Empire Apple Tree**

(Malus 'Empire') Height & Spread: 12-15' Full Sun

A very popular cross of McIntosh and Red Delicious, Empire is a vigorous tree. It is somewhat resistant to fireblight and cedar-apple rust. It is firmer and darker than McIntosh, with a red skin that deepens to purple, and it also has a longer storage life than that of its parent. The flesh of Empire is creamy white with a snappy texture and a sweet, tangy flavor. The juice has some utility in cider blending. This apple has become one of the most commonly cultivated apples in America.

### **Granny Smith Apple Tree**

(Malus 'Granny Smith') Height & Spread: 20' Full Sun

Granny Smith Apple features showy clusters of lightly-scented white flowers with shell pink overtones along the branches in mid spring, which emerge from distinctive pink flower buds. It has forest green deciduous foliage. The pointy leaves turn yellow in fall. The fruits are showy light green apples carried in abundance in early fall. A tart apple with bright green skin, considered among the best for cooking, it has a sweet taste and a crisp texture.

# Hat Trick Apple Tree

(Malus domestica 'Hat Trick') Height & Spread: 16-18' Full Sun

The Hat Trick Apple tree features three outstanding apples on one tree. This apple tree will produce Honeycrisp, Sweet Sixteen, and Zestar apples for easy picking. This cultivar is self-pollinating.

# **Honeycrisp Apple Tree**

(Malus domestica 'Honeycrisp') Height & Spread: 20' Full Sun

This superior red apple with a crunchy, crisp texture boasts a juicy, sweet-tart flavor when picked early, but develops its full-bodied, aromatic profile if left to fully ripen in the mid-late season. You can plan to enjoy it fresh, dried, juiced - it also makes for a superior storage apple. Honeycrisp is one of the most winter-hardy apple trees. Both scab and fireblight resistant, Honeycrisp has quickly become a favorite for the home grower.

# Liberty Apple Tree

(Malus domestica 'Liberty') Height & Spread: 12-15' Full Sun

This apple tree produces large, bright red fruit with a yellowish crisp, juicy flesh. Liberty is resistant to apple scab, cedar-apple rust, fire blight, and mildew. The Liberty Apple is a hardy, vigorous, productive, annual bearer that is good for fresh eating, cooking, canning, and desserts. These apples carry a long storage life.

#### Newtown Pippin Apple Tree

(Malus domestica 'Newtown Pippin') Height: 15-18' Spread: 12-15' Full Sun

The Newtown Pippin Apple is the most famous colonial American apple. It was cultivated by both George Washington and Thomas Jefferson and is still grown today for its superior flavor. The apple is typically light green, sometimes with a yellow tinge. It is often russeted around the stem. The flesh is yellow and crisp. The flavor is delicious, somewhat tart. It is one of the best keeping apples. Originally grown as a dessert apple, the Newtown Pippin Apple is used primarily for cider.

### **SnowSweet Apple Tree**

(Malus 'Wildung') Height & Spread: 12-15' Full Sun

A modern, cold hardy, disease resistant, and very tasty variety, SnowSweet is a pretty medium-large sized apple with skin that is burnished, bronze-red over yellow-green. The flesh is bright white and it is very slow to oxidize, making this an excellent apple for slicing into salads. The texture is breaking and tender, and the flavor is sweet-tart and rich. The developers describe the flavor as "almost buttery". This specimen is also scab and fireblight resistant.

# WineCrisp Apple Tree

(Malus domestica 'Co-op 31') Height & Spread: 15' Full Sun

WineCrisp comes from the disease-resistant breeding program at Purdue, Rutgers, and Illinois Universities. It is resistant to scab, fire blight, and powdery mildew. This dramatically colored, late-season crop is a deep red-purple color that stands out on a pale fall day and it looks almost black from a distance. The skin is rough, but crisp. It has a full, rich flavor with tangy notes of citrus and spice.

# **Black Satin Blackberry**

(Rubus 'Black Satin') Height: 6' Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

The thornless canes of the Black Satin bush are erect, vigorous and disease free. The ebony colored blackberries produced by these bushes are very large, firm, and when completely ripe are a jet black in color with tiny scattered red surface cells that give the berry a slightly tart flavor that balances the sweetness of the juicy berries. This shrub is drought resistant once established.

# **Triple Crown Blackberry**

(Rubus fruticosus 'Triple Crown') Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

The Triple Crown Blackberry is named for its three attributes; flavor, productivity and vigor. This very hardy variety offers two other attributes; remarkable disease resistance and very large berries. It is a semi-erect, self-fruitful, thornless shrub with clusters of pinkish-white, rose-like flowers which give way to a heavy crop of large, glossy black, juicy blackberries. The berries are firm and excel- lent for fresh eating, jams, jellies, and pies. Free-standing, its strong canes can support several pounds of fruit without trellising.

#### **Bluecrop Blueberry**

(Vaccinium corymbosum 'Bluecrop') Height: 4-6' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

Bluecrop is a highbush blueberry cultivar. It produces allpurpose blueberries that are firm and somewhat tart — great for preserves, baking, freezing, and fresh eating. With this shrub, you will harvest as much as 10–20 lbs. of fruit every year. It also provides some nice landscape value with a bloom of white flowers in May and fiery red color in the fall.

### **Duke Blueberry**

(Vaccinium corymbosum 'Duke') Height: 4-6' Spread: 5-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Duke Blueberry is a Northern Highbush Blueberry, growing well in cooler climates and northern regions. It is very cold hardy and blooms later, avoiding spring frosts. It is known both for its early season fruit, which is large with a firm, crisp texture, and its high yield of berries. The fruit has a tangy, sweet, delicate flavor. Its dainty bell-shaped blossoms are white with a blush of pink and are a beautiful sight in the landscape.

# Sweetheart Cherry Fruit Tree

Prunus avium 'Sweetheart' Height: 12-16' Spread: 7-10' Full Sun

This self-fruiting sweet Cherry tree produces delectable dark red fruits. This variety of cherry tree is resistant to rain induced cracking. White and pink blooms decorate its branches in spring. Summer's deep green foliage transforms into hues of blazing orange, red, and pink. This specimen is an excellent choice for smaller

# **Carmine Jewel Dwarf Cherry Tree**

(Prunus fruticosa x Prunus ceracus 'Carmine Jewel') Height: 6-7' Spread: 5-6' Full Sun

Not much bothers this tough but beautiful specimen. The Carmine Jewel is very easy to grow and maintain. It is extremely coldhardy and has almost no issues with pests or disease. It can easily double as an ornamental landscape feature with an attractive growth habit, dense, rich green foliage and lovely pink and white blossoms in the spring. The deep, reddish-purple fruit with darkred flesh just bursts with delicious juices and isn't overly sour or too sweet.

### Montmorency Tart Cherry Tree

(Prunus cerasus 'Montmorency') Height: 15-20' Spread: 15' Full Sun

The most popular sour cherry grown in America, it is a medium to large cherry tree of rounded habit with upright, spreading branches. In mid-spring, it is covered in white flower clusters along its branches. They are followed by a heavy crop of medium-large, bright red cherries with firm yellow flesh in early-mid summer. They have a rich, tangy flavor, resist cracking, and are excellent for pies and preserves.

# **Stella Cherry Tree**

(Prunus avium 'Stella') Height: 15-20' Spread: 12-15' Full Sun

A unique cherry tree that produces an abundance of fruit in its first year of growth, it allows you to enjoy delicious cherries without the long wait. It requires little to no maintenance once it is established and can add a variety of colors to your outdoor space. Lovely white blooms smother the tree in the early spring and are delightfully fragrant. They are quickly followed by clusters of shiny, dark red, nearly black sweet cherries in mid-summer.

### Fantasia Nectarine Tree

(Prunus persica var. nucipersica 'Fantasia') Height: 15-25' Spread: 12-20' Full Sun

Fantasia Nectarine is a handsome tree that shows beautiful and fragrant spring flowers before producing large yellow fleshed nectarines that can be harvested in two stages; firm-ripe and tangy or soft ripe and sweet. It is sweeter and juicier the later the fruit hangs on the tree. This fruit is great for pies and canning.

# **Red Haven Peach Tree**

(Prunus persica 'Red Haven') Height & Spread: 15-20' Full Sun

The vigorous Redhaven Peach tree produces luscious, top-quality fruit. This popular variety is known for being a top producer of large peaches. Fragrant, pink flowers blossom in the spring. When the fruit ripens, enjoy its sweet peaches with almost fuzzless skin over firm, creamy-textured yellow flesh. These freestone peaches are great as a fresh snack, for cooking, and canning. This tree is heavy-bearing and easy to grow. Its branches have a spreading habit. This variety is resistant to leaf spot. It is a self-pollinating fruit tree, making it great for smaller landscapes.

# **Reliance Peach Tree**

(Prunus persica 'Reliance') Height & Spread: 15-20' Full Sun

Noted for its cold-hardiness, this is a vigorous and fast-growing peach tree adorned with profuse soft pink blossoms in early-mid spring. They are followed by a heavy crop of medium-sized, freestone, red-blushed yellow fruits in mid-late summer. The soft yellow flesh has a good flavor. Perfect for eating, baking, and canning. This peach tree forms a rounded crown with upright branches.

#### **Bartlett Pear Tree**

(Pyrus 'Bartlett') Height & Spread: 12-20' Full Sun

America's favorite pear, the Bartlett, is a firm, sweet, and aromatic pear that is great for canning, cooking, and eating fresh. The Bartlett Pear tree is fast growing, hardy, and produces a lot of fruit. It is easy to grow and requires minimal care once established. White spring blossoms bring gorgeous appeal to the landscape.

#### **Bosc Pear Tree**

(Pyrus communis 'Bosc') Height: 12-15' Spread: 12-18' Full Sun

This fragrant, smaller pear tree yields excellent fruit later in the season, making it perfect for extending your harvest. The mid-spring display of sweet white blossoms smothers this tree and draws pollinators. Filling out with handsome vibrant-green foliage, it is highly ornamental. This one-of-a-kind pear provides exceptionally delicious flavor. Its crunchy, crispy, juicy flesh is a late-harvest treat, and the unique, strong spice, sweet flavor develops wonderfully.

### **Lucious Pear Tree**

(Pyrus communus 'Lucious') Height: 10-15' Spread: 8-15' Full Sun

Like the Bartlett, only sweeter and juicier, the Luscious Pear has become an incredibly popular variety. Cold hardy, easy to care for, and producing a bountiful early-fall harvest of delicious pears, this is a wonderful addition to the landscape. Clusters of large white flowers pop in spring. Their fragrance is highly appealing. In fall, the pears ripen and the leaves turn a bold red to burgundy.

# **Comice Pear Tree**

Pyrus communis 'Comice' Height & Width: 12-16' Full Sun

This Pear tree starts the season with a profusion of fragrant, creamy white flowers draping in clusters along the branches. Fall crop is a very large, greenish-yellow pear with a red blush. Their rich flavor is very juicy and buttery. Pollinate with a Pear tree that has a similar bloom time, such as Bartlett.

### **Oriental Asian Pear**

Pyrus pyrifolia Height & Spread: 12-15' Full Sun

Snow white, fragrant blooms cover this tree in spring. Crisp and juicy pears follow these booms with smooth yellow skin and a delicious, sweet flesh. Fall brings a remarkable display of color when green foliage changes to red, purple, and burgundy. This specimen is selffertile, but performs best when pollinated with the Bartlett pear or another Asian pear.

# Mount Royal Plum Tree

(Prunus domestica 'Mount Royal') Height: 10-12' Spread: 8-10' Full Sun

Extremely cold hardy, this small European plum tree is spectacular. In mid-spring, it bursts into a profusion of sweetly fragrant blossoms. They are followed in late summer or early fall by a heavy crop of medium-sized, freestone, dark blue plums with a greenish-yellow flesh. Juicy, sweet, and delicious, the plums have a rich flavor and are perfect for snacking, canning, or making jelly. This tree is self-fertile but yields more heavily when pollinated with another.

# **Stanley Plum Tree**

(Prunus domestica 'Stanley') Height & Spread: 8-20' Full Sun

Extremely cold hardy and reliable, this is a vigorous European plum tree with a spreading canopy. In mid-spring, it bursts into a profusion of sweetly fragrant blossoms, creating a spectacular display. They are followed in late summer or early fall by a heavy crop of large, dark blue plums with a greenish-yellow meaty flesh. Juicy, sweet, and delicious, the plums have a rich flavor and are perfect for snacking, canning, or making jelly. This tree is self-fertile but yields more heavily when pollinated with another.

### **Chicago Hardy Fig**

(Ficus carica 'Chicago Hardy') Height: 10-15' Spread: 9-12' Full Sun

The Chicago Hardy Fig tree is productive and easy to grow, exhibiting drought-tolerance once established. It may die back in colder climates and resume growth in the spring. It bears fruit early on its new growth. Figs that grow on the older wood will appear in early summer. This plant is both heat tolerant and selfpollinating, meaning that it does not need to be planted near another variety of fig to produce fruit.

# **Encore Raspberry**

(Rubus 'Encore') Height: 5-6' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

With sweet white flowers in spring and textured dark green foliage, Encore is an attractive addition to an edible landscape. This coldhardy and adaptable variety easily extends the season of fresh berries for many weeks. The picking is easy with the nearly thornless canes that are mostly upright.

### **Heritage Raspberry**

(Rubus idaeus 'Heritage') Height: 5-6' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

Among the most widely grown cultivars worldwide, this specimen is an upright, self-fruitful, thorny shrub which produces 2 crops on each cane: a moderate crop in early summer followed by a heavy crop in the fall. Clusters of white, rose-like flowers give way to large, extra-sweet, juicy, dark red raspberries, which are great for canning, freezing or fresh eating.

# Bushel & Berry Shortcake Dwarf Raspberry

(Rubus idaeus 'NR7') Height: 2-3' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

Perfect for small gardens and containers, this variety of raspberry is a compact, self-pollinating, thornless shrub that yields an abundance of sweet red raspberries. Clusters of white, rose-like flowers give way to full-size berries which ripen in early to midsummer. This variety is self-supporting and great for patios where this charming rounded shrub is sure to add a little burst of brilliant color.

# Specimens

Specimen plants create a dramatic effect and add value to the landscape. They serve as stunning focal points that do not need to be mass planted in order to be noticeable.

# **Amethyst Falls Wisteria**

(Wisteria frutescens 'Amethyst Falls') Height: 18-20' Spread: 10-15' Full Sun

This hybrid of native wisteria has abundant, fragrant lilac-colored blooms of wisterias, but less inclination to spread aggressively. Heavy blooming starts in late spring with 4 to 6-inch flower clusters all over the plant. This specimen is both deer resistant and drought-tolerant.

#### **Tricolor Beech**

(Fagus sylvatica 'Tricolor') Height: 25-35' Spread: 20-25' Sun/ Part Shade

This unique shade tree is truly a statement piece. It slowly develops

a majestic, ovate form. Its attractive, variegated foliage is purplegreen with irregularly colored rose-pink edges. The dramatic color of the Tricolor Beech makes it an incredible feature that is sure to stand out in any landscape.

# **Copper Beech (Purple Beech)**

Fagus sylvatica f. Purpurea Height: 60-80' Spread: 40-60' Sun/ Part Shade

This distinctive and dramatic specimen tree is adored for its stunning hues of deep purple. Its fall color takes on a beautiful copper hue. Tassel-like catkins hang from long stalks in April & May, inviting pollinators. Its female flowers give way to reddishbrown Beech nuts that are enjoyed by wildlife. The dense canopy of this tree casts a wonderful, cooling shade.

# Horstmann's Silberlocke Fir

(Abies koreana 'Horstmann's Silberlocke') Height: 6-12' Spread: 2-6' Sun/ Part Shade

This dwarf evergreen is a charming addition to any landscape. Its pyrimidal form is neat and naturally symmetrical. Green needles have silver undersides, giving them a frosted appearance. Cones are purple in spring and grow upright, creating outstanding contrast. No trimming is necessary for this tree, as it has a tidy habit. It thrives best in lighter soils and has no significant pest or disease issues.

# Wintergold Fir

(Abies concolor 'Wintergold') Height: 10' Spread: 6' Sun/ Part Shade

This dwarf variety of White Fir is a very unique accent that will add fine texture and brilliant color to the landscape. Its seasonably variable needles are truly spectacular. New growth is a bright chartreuse, contrasting with the previous season's buttery-yellow growth. The needles mature to a dark green before transforming into a brilliant golden yellow in winter. This slow-growing evergreen has tiered, horizontal branches that display its foliage beautifully.

# Select Blue Concolor Fir

Abies concolor 'Select Blue' Height: 15-20' Spread: 10-15' Full Sun

This Fir displays powder blue foliage that is usually high contrast to other plants in the landscape. It is somewhat adaptable and makes a wonderful, vertical accent because of its distinctive pyramidal habit. This tree will benefit from being planted in a sheltered location.

# **Blue Cloak Concolor Fir**

(Abies concolor 'Blue Cloak') Height: 10' Spread: 4' Sun/ Part Shade

This lovely specimen is sure to provide captivating interest in your landscape. It is a compact and pendulous version of the White Fir. It is a slow-grower with a dense form. Thin powder-blue needles create a very soft and fine texture. This tree benefits from being planted in a relatively sheltered location to avoid harsh winds.

### **Robbie's Twist Ginkgo**

Ginkgo biloba 'Robbies Twist' Height & Spread: 8-15' Sun/ Part Shade

This unique specimen takes on a very dramatic upright habit, branching upwards amongst itself, starting to twist and turn. Foliage is very narrow and slightly twisted from their base. Emerging green, the leaves age to a bright golden yellow. This specimen has good urban tolerance and is a captivating addition to the landscape.

# Chi-Chi Ginkgo

(Ginkgo biloba 'Chi-Chi') Height: 4-5' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

A gorgeous, contrasting specimen, the Chi-Chi Ginkgo is a dwarf variety of ginkgo that provides brilliant color in a more compact form. Light green, fanned leaves turn a brilliant golden yellow in fall. Its slow-growing, dense, and rounded form makes it an excellent specimen for small spaces. This tree has good deer resistance, is tolerant of urban environments, and has virtually no insect or disease issues.

#### **Columnar Dwarf Hornbeam**

(Carpinus betulus 'Columnaris Nana') Height: 6-8' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

This Hornbeam is primarily valued in the landscape for its rigidly columnar form. It has forest green foliage and a dense, narrowly upright growth habit. Glossy and pointy leaves turn an outstanding gold in the fall. The smooth gray bark adds an interesting dimension to the landscape. Its relatively fine texture sets it apart from others in the landscape.

# **Bloodgood Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum var. atropurpureum 'Bloodgood') Height: 15-20' Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

A truly artistic specimen that is easy to care for, the Bloodgood Japanese Maple will add attractive color and texture to the landscape. Burgundy foliage transforms into a brilliant scarlet red in fall. Along with its dramatic color, its open and spreading branching habit is spectacular. This slow-growing tree is also versatile, being hardy and having good sun tolerance.

#### **Crimson Queen Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum var. dissectum 'Crimson Queen') Height: 6-8' Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

This variety of Japanese maple brings outstanding interest to any landscape. Delicate, weeping branches are decorated with lacy crimson foliage. Fall color is a vibrant scarlet red. This tree is Black Walnut tolerant, adaptable to clay soils, drought-tolerant once established, and more sun tolerant than most Japanese maples.

# Firecracker Japanese Maple

(Acer palmatum var. dissectum 'Firecracker') Height: 5-6' Spread: 6-7' Sun/ Part Shade

This slow-growing Japanese maple is an amazing investment for your landscape. Cascading branches develop a dense, mounded form. Lacy foliage emerges ruby red in spring, darkens to burgundy with green accents, and eventually becomes bright scarlet in fall. It leafs out in a manner that makes it appear as though the leaves are exploding out of its branches.

# North Wind Japanese Maple

(Acer x pseudosieboldianum 'North Wind') Height: 20' Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

The North Wind Japanese Maple exhibits increased durability and outstanding winter hardiness in comparison to other cultivars. Finely serrated foliage appears in vibrant shades of red in spring, changing to delicate light green in midsummer. Enjoy the spectacular show when its leaves turn to rich orange-red in fall. This cultivar makes an excellent substitute for traditional Japanese maples in colder climates. It also has good salt tolerance.

# **Orange Flame Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum 'Orange Flame') Height: 15' Spread: 8-10' Part Shade/ Shade

The hardy Orange Flame Japanese Maple is an upright, strong grower, with a deeply lobed leaf. In spring, new leaves emerge orange and turn a pleasing light green in summer. The second round of new growth in summer lights up like a flame – hence the name. It has a truly captivating fall color which is bright red, along with hues of oranges and yellows. Its winter bark color is also orange on newer growth.

# **Purple Ghost Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum 'Purple Ghost') Height & Spread: 8-10' Part Shade/ Shade

The Purple Ghost Japanese Maple is a lovely focal point for more shaded areas of your landscape. It is densely branched with an upright and spreading habit. Lacy foliage is red-purple with prominent veins and changes to a vibrant shade of garnet in fall. It displays its best color in partial shade.

# **Red Emperor Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum 'Wolff') Height & Spread: 15' Sun/ Part Shade

The Red Emperor Japanese Maple is upright with a spreading habit, giving it an artistic form. Dark red foliage transforms into a brilliant crimson in fall. Avoid planting this tree in overexposed, dry areas. It is fast-growing and somewhat tolerant of urban conditions.

### Summer Gold Japanese Maple

(Acer almatum 'Summer Gold') Height: 8-12' Spread: 4-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Summer Gold Japanese Maple is a tough specimen with a charming display of color. Showy foliage emerges light green, brightening throughout the summer to yellow-green with a red border. Fall color is a contrasting array of deep orange and fiery red tones. This colorful statement tree is more heat tolerant than other types of Japanese maple and can be planted in areas exposed to more sun.

# Tamukeyama Japanese Maple

(Acer palmatum var. dissectum 'Tamukeyama') Height: 6-8' Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

This ancient specimen is considered one of the best Japanese maples by horticulturists. It is very low-maintenance with a mounded and compact form. Cascading, lacy foliage emerges deep shades of red-purple, brightening to brilliant red in summer, and transforms into a bright scarlet red in fall. Its bark is a stunning deep red, providing gorgeous winter interest. This tree is the perfect graceful accent that will add an artistic sense to your landscape.

#### **Twombley's Red Sentinel Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum 'Twombley's Red Sentinel') Height: 10-15' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Twombley's Red Sentinel Japanese Maple is a unique, narrow specimen, excellent for more restricted spaces. Foliage emerges bright red, darkens through summer, and transforms into a brilliant scarlet red in fall. Bare red stems provide a small touch of winter interest. Slow-growing and low-maintenance, it is an ideal choice for an easily cared-for focal point.

#### **Bloodleaf Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum 'Atropurpureum') Height: 15-25' Spread: 20' Sun/ Part Shade

This tough variety of Japanese maple is a very handsome specimen that will add lovely character to the landscape. Its branches are cloaked in lush purple foliage in spring. Summer color is purple-green and its fall color is a gorgeous shade of burgundy that provides pretty contrast. The upright habit of this tree makes it an excellent standalone specimen. While this tree tolerates full sun, it performs and displays its color best in part shade.

# **Red Dragon Japanese Maple**

(Acer palmatum var. dissectum 'Red Dragon') Height: 7-8' Spread: 5' Sun/ Part Shade

The graceful Red Dragon Japanese Maple is a unique accent tree. Deeply dissected, lacy foliage starts off a deep shade of maroon and turns bright red in fall. Its cascading and mounding form is greatly adored by many. It is both hardy and slowgrowing, making it very easy to care for. Its small, compact size makes this an excellent specimen to plant near a porch or patio and admire its beauty.

### Shaina Japanese Maple

(Acer palmatum 'Shaina') Height: 4-6' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

A dense, slow-growing Japanese Maple, this tree is a marvelous addition to the landscape. Its dwarf form makes it suitable for small gardens. In spring, bright red leaves cover its upright branches. Foliage darkens to a deep shade of red in summer before changing to crimson in fall. This low-maintenance tree makes an excellent

specimen near porches or patios.

### **Green Dwarf Pin Oak**

(Quercus palustris) Height & Spread: 8-10' Full Sun

The Green Dwarf Pin Oak is a rare cultivar, as it is smaller than the classic Pin Oak. Slow-growing and dense, this specimen appears as a shrub until it matures into a more tree-like form. It develops a dense, pyramidal crown. Lush, glossy green foliage transforms into deep shades of red in fall. Its compact form makes it a perfect specimen tree for smaller areas.

# **Orangeola Laceleaf Japanese Maple**

Acer palmatum 'Orangeola' Height: 4-8' Spread: 3-7' Sun/ Part Shade

Known as one of the most spectacular, cascading, laceleaf Japanese Maples, it is adored for its remarkable bright orange foliage that takes on a red-green hue later in the season. This two-toned specimen is a unique, low-maintenance addition to the landscape.

#### Lemon Lime Lace Japanese Maple

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Lemon Lime Lace' Height & Spread: 4' Sun/ Part Shade

This small, mounding, Japanese Maple is covered in deeply divided, lemon-lime colored leaves that gracefully cascade down from its branches. Yellow-orange hues transform this specimen in fall, creating stunning interest. This specimen adds a soft, lacy texture to the landscape while also adding a captivating pop of color. Its small, compact stature is very low-maintenance.

#### **Ruby Star Japanese Maple**

Acer palmatum 'Ruby Star' Height & Spread: 3-6' Part Shade

This new dwarf cultivar of Japanese Maple has small, ruby red, star-shaped foliage. Fall brings hues of red, orange, and yellow. Its compact, slow-growing form requires little maintenance. This eye-catching specimen can easily fit in shady areas of the landscape.

# Ice Dragon Japanese Maple

Acer x pseudosieboldianum 'IsliD' Height: 8-10' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

Bred for its improved cold hardiness, Ice Dragon not only withstands summer heat, but also tolerates cooler climates up to zone 4. Fine and feathery foliage unfurls bright red-orange before quickly turning green. Its fall colors are hues of yellow, orange, and red.

#### **Golden Norway Spruce**

Picea abies 'Aurea' Height: 35' Spread: 15' Full Sun

This highly ornamental tree creates spectacular interest with chartreuse foliage that gracefully covers its neat, pyramidal form. Its form stays tidy with little to no maintenance. This tree is rarely browsed by deer. This specimen makes a wonderful statement planting.

# Weeping White Spruce

Picea glauca 'Pendula' Height: 20-30' Spread: 6-10' Sun/ Part Shade

Densely packed needles cover the pendulous branches of this weeping specimen. Its dramatic habit makes this an excellent statement piece. This low-maintenance, deer-resistant shrub is a wonderful addition to the landscape.

# **Columnar Norway Spruce**

(Picea abies 'Cupressina') Height: 20' Spread: 5-6' Full Sun

The Columnar Norway Spruce is a hardy and elegant evergreen. Perfect for a screen or as a specimen tree, it has a dense, narrow, upright form. It is fast-growing and has a charming, rich green color that can be enjoyed all year. This is a relatively low-maintenance tree that deer tend to not care for.

# **Paul's Select Norway Spruce**

(Picea abies 'Paul's Select') Height: 10-20' Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

This evergreen tree is perfect for small spaces and has great cold hardiness. The unique blue color of this Norway spruce makes it a standout in any garden as it glows against the backdrop of green plants and the winter snow. It looks fresh and bright through every season. This standout plant has stature, brilliance and beauty, combined with sturdiness, ease of growth, and cold hardiness.

#### **Thunderbolt Spruce**

(Picea glauca var. densata 'Charlie J. Nickel') Height: 35-40' Spread: 30-35' Full Sun

This new cultivar of white spruce tree is adored for its densely packed needles that are tinted blue in color. Its uniform and ovate habit creates a very handsome form. This contrasting specimen is a wonderful feature that will bring charm and color to the landscape. This spruce is deer-resistant.

# **Dwarf Blue Globe Spruce**

(Picea pungens 'Globosa') Height: 3-5' Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part shade

This charming, globe-shaped evergreen shrub is a unique dwarf spruce. It has a neat, rounded habit that is densely branched. The bright blue needles hold their color all year long, but are a brighter hue in summer. It acts as a unique accent that adds interesting color and texture to the landscape.

### **Howell's Dwarf Tigertail Spruce**

(Picea bicolor 'Howell's Dwarf Tigertail') Height: 15-20' Spread: 10-15' Sun/ Part shade

This spruce is the most colorful of all, with a unique color combination of bright silver-blue on the undersides of the needles and green on top. It is an attractive, hardy dwarf conifer that forms a mound, which can be kept in this way by pruning upward growing shoots. If the central leader is left alone, a pyramidal tree will eventually form. An especially attractive feature of this tree is the reddish-purple cones that form on mature trees in the spring.

# **Dwarf Alberta Spiral Spruce**

(Picea glauca 'Conica') Height: 5-7' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Dwarf Alberta Spruce is a wonderfully dense, slow growing tree that is the perfect pyramidal accent plant. This specimen has been pruned into its spiral form and acts as a living sculpture. This gorgeous formal design element requires little pruning to maintain its shape. Deer do not care for it and it easily grows in well-drained soils.

# **Morris Blue Pine**

(Pinus koraiensis 'Morris Blue') Height: 12' Spread: 6' Full Sun

This variety of pine is a slow growing, narrowly pyramidal pine. It displays elegant, long bluish-green needles on its upright branches. It is low-maintenance and creates stunning interest year-round. This pine is quite intolerant of urban conditions.

#### **Hindu-Pan Scots Pine**

(Pinus sylvestris 'Hindu-Pan') Height & Spread: 3-6' Full Sun

The Hindu-Pan Scots Pine is a dwarf, upright cultivar. It features twisted blue-green needles in pairs as well as flaking orange/red-brown bark and gray to light brown cones. This specimen is a fantastic feature in the landscape when pruned to sculpturesque forms. It is tolerant of many soils as long as it has good drainage. This conifer is deer resistant.

#### Vanderwolf Pine

(Pinus flexilis 'Vanderwolfs') Height: 20-25' Spread: 10-15' Sun/ Part Shade

The Vanderwolf Pine is a more distinct and interesting variety of pine. It slowly grows into a dense and compact, pyramidal shape. Branches emerge low to the ground, at the base of the trunk, with an upright habit. Blue-green needles decorate its flexible branches. This pine has great resistance to pests and diseases and is highly adaptable. This hardy specimen will add uniqueness and beautiful texture to your landscape.

# Irish Bell Bosnian Pine

Pinus leucodermis 'Irish Bell' Height: 4' Spread: 3' Full Sun

This dwarf evergreen tree has a broad pyramidal form that resembles a bell. Its compact form stays neat with little to no maintenance. Bright green, straight needles cloak its branches and retain their color year-round. This handsome specimen is great in low borders and hedges.

#### Miss Grace Dawn Redwood

Metasequoia glyptostroboides 'Miss Grace' Height: 8' Spread: 3' Sun/ Part Shade

'Miss Grace' is the first Metasequoia cultivar with a prominent weeping habit. If branches are staked to allow the foliage to drape, a living sculpture will take form. Needle-like deciduous foliage reveals peeling bark and the artistic bare structure of this tree, providing wonderful winter interest.

# **Evergreens** & Broadleaf

Retain lively color in the landscape year-round by including evergreen specimens in your design.

# **Canadian Hemlock**

(Tsuga canadensis) Height: 50-60' Spread: 25-35' Sun/ Part Shade

The Canadian Hemlock is a more shade-tolerant evergreen that performs best in sheltered planting sites in avoidance of harsh winds. Its thin needles and open branching habit give this specimen a very fine and lacy feel. New growth is light green before maturing to dark green. Brown pinecones are small and abundant, decorating the tree like little ornaments. Use the Canadian Hemlock to add lovely texture and evergreen color to the landscape.

#### **Gold Mops Cypress**

(Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Golden Mop') Height: 3-4' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Adding the Gold Mops Cypress to the landscape is an excellent way to add soft texture and vibrant contrast. Soft and lacy foliage is a brilliant yellow-green color. Performing best in full sun, foliage turns bright golden yellow. This very lowmaintenance shrub is a slow grower with a pyramidal form. It is hardy and also has good insect and disease resistance.

### Soft Serve False Cypress

Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Dow Whiting' Height: 10' Spread: 6' Sun/ Part Shade

This False Cypress adds structure to the landscape with its defined pyramidal habit. Fern-like evergreen foliage is soft and fragrant. This specimen is very easily cared for and deer tend to not care for it. Its salt-tolerance and hardiness withstands urban/ exposed planting sites.

# Soft Serve False Cypress

Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Dow Whiting' Height: 10' Spread: 6' Sun/ Part Shade

This False Cypress adds structure to the landscape with its defined pyramidal habit. Fern-like evergreen foliage is soft and fragrant. This specimen is very easily cared for and deer tend to not care for it. Its salt-tolerance and hardiness withstands urban/ exposed planting sites.

### **Planet Earth Arborvitae**

Thuja occidentalis 'RutThu4' Height & Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

This medium-sized evergreen shrub keeps its neat, round form with minimal pruning. This specimen will soften the texture of the landscape with its lush green foliage. Its hardiness and adaptability make it easy to care for. Use it in borders or as a low hedge.

### **Golden Tuffet Arborvitae**

Thuja occidentalis 'Golden Tuffet' Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This compact conifer has a dense, mounded form and attractive yellow spring foliage that matures to a golden orange color with hints of lime green. Foliage retains its color very well throughout winter. This specimen adds fine, delicate texture to the landscape and provides interest to borders or groupings.

# Full Speed A Hedge 'American Pillar' Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'American Pillar') Height: 15-20' Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

The American Pillar Arborvitae is the fastest way to grow your own privacy screening! Its narrow habit allows this tree to be planted alongside others to create the perfect hedge. Lush green foliage is attractive year-round. This cultivar is deer resistant, heat tolerant, and cold hardy.

### **Brabant Arborvitae**

(Thuja occidentalis 'Brabant') Height: 12-15' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

This conifer has a dense crown and a narrow pyramidal growth habit. The bark is reddish brown and peeling off in long strips. The flattened, highly branched young twigs are green before turning orange-brown. It is bright green and retains color well in winter too. When crushed the foliage gives off a pleasant fragrance. Pruning is tolerated well which has led to the popularity of this specimen as hedge plant. It is adaptable to almost any soil and is very hardy.

# **Emerald Green Arborvitae**

(Thuja occidentalis 'Smaragd') Height: 15' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

This gorgeous evergreen is an excellent choice for a formal privacy screen. It is especially, but not exclusively, an incredible specimen plant because of its dense, rich green foliage that lasts year-round. This conifer's attractive, upright, and defined form doesn't require pruning, but tolerates light pruning. If desired, it can be lightly trimmed to a preferred shape if done intermittently.

# Fire Chief Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'Congabe') Height & Spread: 4' Sun/ Part Shade

This slow-growing evergreen holds a neat, globose form while adding fiery contrast to the landscape. Its tidy form requires no pruning at all. Foliage is golden in spring, orange in summer, and red in fall. Best color is achieved in full sun. This arborvitae is the perfect small planting for limited spaces and can thrive almost anywhere.

### **Green Giant Arborvitae**

(Thuja plicata 'Green Giant') Height: 25-30' Spread: 10-12' Sun/ Part Shade

These fast growing arborvitae are absolutely stunning. Their lush, dark green foliage is fragrant and attractive year-round. Due to their uniform growth habit they require little to no pruning. Deer tend to not care for this tree. It is virtually pest and disease-free as well. Use the Green Giant Arborvitae as a durable windbreak tree. It can also be planted as a single specimen to use as a beautiful accent in your landscape.

# Holmstrup Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'Holmstrup') Height: 5-7' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

The Holmstrup Arborvitae is prized for its neat and formal look. It is a smaller, slow-growing variety that is covered in extremely dense green foliage. Use this specimen as a handsome border planting or dense privacy screen.

#### Mr. Bowling Ball Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'Bobozam') Height & Spread: 24"-30" Full Sun

The Mr. Bowling Ball Arborvitae is a naturally rounded dwarf shrub with dense, feathery, bright green/golden foliage. The lacy, foliage has excellent year-round color retention, especially in full sun. It is very useful as a low hedge and in foundation plantings, especially in areas where space is limited.

# North Pole Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'Art Boe') Height: 10-15' Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This columnar variety of arborvitae is a hardy evergreen that is resistant to winter burn. It is a more narrow type, allowing it to be planted in tighter spaces. Stunning dark green foliage looks magnificent year round. Use this low-maintenance evergreen as a privacy screen or as a bold accent.

### Pancake Arborvitae

Thuja occidentalis 'Concesarini' Height: 1' Spread: 2' Full Sun

This finely textured, sage-green evergreen has a low, dense, rounded habit. Foliage tints slightly blue in fall and winter. This tiny evergreen is hardy and easy to maintain. It thrives in full sun and resists burning but will tolerate some shade. It can be used as a low border or as a charming hedge.

# Pyramidal Arborvitae

(Arborvitae 'Pyramidalis') Height: 15-25' Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

The Pyramidal Arborvitae is a fast-growing, tall, and narrow arborvitae. It has bright green, soft-textured foliage. This tall evergreen requires little or no trimming to maintain its narrow form. It can be used as an excellent screen, hedge, or windbreak. Enjoy this low-maintenance evergreen almost anywhere in the landscape.

# Technito Arborvitae

(Arborvitae occidentalis 'Bailjohn') Height: 10' Spread: 5' Sun/ Part Shade

This dwarf variety of the popular Techny Arborvitae is primarily valued in the landscape for its distinctively pyramidal habit of growth. It has dark green foliage which emerges light green in spring and retains a rich green color in winter.

### **Techny Arborvitae**

(Thuja occidentalis 'Techny') Height: 15' Spread: 8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Techny Arborvitae is adored for both its beauty and its versatility. Deep green foliage covers its tall and narrow form. This very adaptable tree is hardy, wind-resistant, and can tolerate wetter soil conditions. Techny Arborvitae are a top pick for creating a living privacy fence that looks full and provides color year-round.

#### Hetz Wintergreen Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'Hetz Wintergreen') Height: 25' Spread: 6' Full Sun

The charming Hetz Wintergreen Arborvitae is an excellent variety of American Arborvitae trees. This durable selection stays a rich green all year long. For a fast, reliable, green privacy screen or an attractive, conical green accent, this adaptable, hardy tree is the perfect choice.

## Woodward Globe Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'Woodwardi') Height: 4-10' Spread: 8-15' Full Sun

A popular choice for hedges and foundation plantings, the Woodward Globe Arborvitae is a naturally neat sphere that is sure to add stunning definition to any landscape. It is a compact evergreen with a naturally broad and round form.

#### Yellow Ribbon Arborvitae

(Thuja occidentalis 'Yellow Ribbon') Height: 8-10' Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This distinctive evergreen with showy, dense golden-yellow foliage maintains its color wonderfully throughout the year. It thrives in humid conditions. Use it as a unique accent to brighten the landscape year-round. It works well for borders, privacy screening, or anywhere in the landscape where brilliant color is needed.

## Forever Goldy Arborvitae

Thuja plicata '4Ever' Height: 10-12' Spread: 3-3.5' Full Sun

This upright & pyramidal conifer has bright golden foliage. It contrasts wonderfully among typical green foliage. Its fine texture sets it apart from more coarse plants in the landscape. The heat and sun tolerance of this specimen are very impressive. This deer-resistant tree works wonderfully in borders and hedges.

## Spring Grove Arborvitae

Thuja plicata 'Grovepli' Height: 30' Spread: 12' Full Sun

This fast-growing, cold hardy selection of Western Arborvitae is a superior specimen adored for its winter color and hardiness. It maintains a rich, glossy, dark green color even in frigid conditions. This deer-resistant conifer is an excellent choice for creating privacy screens.

#### Hetz Midget Arborvitae

Thuja occidentalis 'Hetz Midget' Height: 3-4' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

A dwarf Arborvitae with a neat globe form, the Hetz Midget can single handedly transform the design of your landscape. This slow-grower is compact and rounded, keeping its form almost maintenance-free. Fine green foliage brings a soft texture to the landscape and contrasts wonderfully amongst more coarse plants.

## Junior Giant Arborvitae

Thuja plicata x standishii 'Junion Giant' Height: 15-20' Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

Junior Giant is 'Green Giant's baby brother, sharing the same, dark green, feathery foliage. Their difference is size. Easily fit Junior Giant into smaller areas, adding a touch of formal structure to the landscape. It is adaptable and shade tolerant, but prefers full sun.

#### Northern Spire Arborvitae

Thuja plicata 'Northern Spire' Height: 15-20' Spread: 5' Sun/ Part Shade

Similar to the 'Emerald Green', Northern Spire is a taller, more narrow option. Foliage is dark green, and gives this specimen a textured appearance. This slim conifer is ideal for creating thinner privacy screens. Deer do not care for this tree.

#### Andorra Juniper

Juniperus horizontalis 'Pulmosa Compacta' Height: 1-1.5' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

This Juniper is a low-growing, dense, and compact evergreen. Its feathery green foliage turns plum-red when cooler temperatures arrive in fall. The soft texture of this shrub brings elegance to the landscape. This specimen looks great when planted in masses or used as a groundcover. This Juniper would benefit from a somewhat sheltered planting site.

## **Blue Point Juniper**

(Juniperus chinensis 'Blue Point') Height: 12' Spread: 8' Full Sun

The Blue Point Juniper is a favorite for stately lawn specimens and tall screens. It features blue-green foliage on a densely branched, broad pyramid form that maintains itself well with practically no pruning. This charming evergreen makes a wonderful formal accent in entrances or on patios.

## **Blue Star Juniper**

(Juniperus squamata 'Blue Star') Height: 2-3' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

The Blue Star Juniper is a dwarf evergreen that makes a graceful accent in any landscape. This slow-grower is densely branched with a spreading habit. Foliage is an icy blue-green with an eye-catching sparkle to it. It is very low-maintenance and drought-tolerant once established.

#### **Daub's Frosted Juniper**

(Juniperus chinensis 'Daub's Frosted') Height: 1-2' Spread: 5' Full Sun

This variety of juniper is a vigorous grower that will brighten your landscape. Its low, spreading habit is very attractive in any landscape. Branches point in multiple directions, making its bright new growth stand out even more. Foliage is bluegreen once mature and new foliage emerges golden yellow. Deer tend to not care for this shrub.

## **Fairview Juniper**

(Juniperus chinensis 'Fairview') Height: 15-18' Spread: 6' Full Sun

The Fairview Juniper is a visually striking specimen with a handsome form. Green foliage densely covers its strong, upright branches. In late summer/early fall, powdery blue berries emerge and remain until late winter. Wildlife love this tree, but deer do not care for it. Once established, it has good drought tolerance. This juniper has also shown good resistance to cedar apple rust.

## **Gold Lace Juniper**

(Juniperus chinensis 'Gold Lace') Height: 4-5' Spread: 5-7' Full sun

The brilliant Gold Lace Juniper is a quick grower that has a very naturally attractive form. Upright and arching branches are covered in thin, feathery foliage. New growth emerges as brilliant golden yellow hues in spring before maturing to a vibrant light green. Its low and spreading habit makes this specimen a unique accent for areas that receive full sun. This juniper is very cold hardy and has good drought tolerance once established. Deer tend to not care for this plant.

#### **Hillspire Juniper**

(Juniperus virginiana 'Hillspire') Height: 12-15' Spread: 4-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The Hillspire Juniper is a dense, compact-pyramidal, symmetrical tree. It has an upright, ascending branching habit that creates a very attractive texture. It features bright green foliage that can be enjoyed year-round.

## Mountbatten Juniper

(Juniperus chinensis 'Mountbatten') Height: 15-20' Spread: 12-15'

The Mountbatten Juniper is an adaptable and hardy cultivar of Chinese Juniper. Gray-green needles have great color retention throughout the year. This Juniper can tolerate a wide variety of soil conditions once established, but avoid planting in wet areas.

## Sea Green Juniper

(Juniperus chinensis 'Sea Ĝreen') Height: 4-6' Spread: 6-8' Full Sun

The Sea Green Juniper is a compact, evergreen shrub with a fountain-like, arching habit. It is low-maintenance, adaptable, and drought-tolerant once established. This juniper features feathery, dark green foliage which is attractive year-round by adding color and texture to the landscape. Deer do not care for this specimen.

#### **Taylor Juniper**

(Juniperus virginiana 'Taylor') Height: 20' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

The semi-soft, blue-green foliage and narrow columnar form provides a refined, elegant look. This handsome selection maintains a denser, upright form than other junipers. It makes a great privacy screen as well as a vertical accent in the landscape. This specimen is deer-resistant.

## Tortuga Juniper

(Juniperus communis 'Tortuga') Height: 2' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Tortuga Juniper is one of the toughest evergreens native to North America. It beautifies the landscape all year long with its pleasing emerald-green foliage. It naturally grows as a handsome, low-mounded groundcover. This incredible specimen withstands cold, sun, drought, deer, rabbits, air pollution, and even black walnut trees.

## **Golden Joy Juniper**

Juniperus x pfitzeriana 'Golden Joy' Height: 3' Spread: 6' Sun/ Part Shade

An improved species of golden Juniper, this specimen is a brighter yellow with better color retention throughout the year. Its spreading, compact form grows slowly and is easy to manage. Feathery foliage softens the texture of the landscape. This Juniper works wonderful as a groundcover.

## **Bird's Nest Spruce**

(Picea abies 'Nidiformis') Height: 3-4' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

This versatile, dwarf conifer is an excellent choice for an evergreen border, accent or container plant. The outward-curving branches with dense, dark green needles create an interesting bird's nest effect and provide unique interest year-round. Its tight and compact shape requires very little maintenance. It is very hardy and wind resistant.

# **Black Hills Spruce**

(Picea glauca var. densata) Height: 20-40' Spread: 10-15' Full Sun

The desirable, symmetrical cone shape of this conifer is highly valued in the landscape. Dense bright-green needles mature to an interesting blue-green and provide excellent color to the landscape year-round. This is a great accent that is useful as windbreak or screening. This tree is very attractive to birds.

#### **Skinny Blue Genes Black Hills Spruce**

(Picea glauca var. densata 'Westervelt') Height: 25' Spread: 8' Full Sun

This charming spruce has a dense, conical, narrow growth habit. Its rich blue needles are admired all year as they provide unique color and texture to the landscape. With its great cold tolerance, drought tolerance, and deer resistance, it makes an excellent lowmaintenance landscape specimen.

## **Meyer's Spruce**

(Picea meyeri) Height: 30-60' Spread: 15-20' Full Sun

Meyer's Spruce tree, also known as Chinese Blue Spruce, is a slow-growing evergreen with gorgeous character. Its rich blue-green needles and excellent needle retention make this a popular choice for an ornamental accent and windbreak tree. Bark is gray-brown and irregularly flakes, creating interest year-round, especially in winter. Meyer's Spruce trees are often planted in place of Blue Spruce trees.

## **Norway Spruce**

(Picea abies) Height: 40-60' Spread: 25-30' Full Sun

The Norway Spruce is a large pyramidal conifer noted for its rapid growth. Its branches are slightly upturned but become pendulous as the tree matures. Branches are filled with spirally-arranged, needle-like, deep green leaves. Cylindrical seed bearing cones grow up to 9" long and are pendulous. Deer do not care for this specimen and it is very tolerant of urban conditions.

#### Serbian Spruce

(Picea omorika) Height: 50-60' Spread: 20-25' Sun/ Part Shade

Tall and slender, with graceful upswept branches, the Serbian Spruce is an elegant evergreen tree specimen in the landscape. It has glossy, dark green needles with slender streaks of white, and distinctive purple cones. It is an adaptable and drought-tolerant tree.

## **Eastern White Pine**

(Pinus strobus) Height: 50-80' Spread: 20-40' Full Sun

This native, hardy, and valuable tree is perfect for landscapes with ample space. Its feathery needles, open canopy, and straight trunk get even more picturesque with age. This tree is fast-growing and long-lived, allowing you to enjoy this specimen as much as possible.

## Slowmound Mugo Pine

(Pinus mugo 'Slowmound') Height & Spread: 2-3' Full Sun

A rugged and hardy evergreen with an evenly mounded habit, this pine is extremely attractive in the landscape. Finely textured, rich deep green foliage creates interesting texture and provides gorgeous year- round color. Slow growing and compact, it rarely needs pruning or maintenance. This pine has good salt tolerance and can tolerate urban sites well. Deer do not care for it.

## Stonehenge Dark Druid Yew

Taxus x media 'SMNTHDB' Height: 3-4' Spread: 3' Full Sun

Dark Druid brings a new size and shape option to the Yew palette. Soft, fern-like, evergreen foliage drapes over this smaller mounded yew. It fits easily in the landscape, requiring almost no maintenance. This shrub is an ideal substitute for Boxwood.

#### Brown's Yew

(Taxus x media 'Brownii') Height: 6' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The dense, rounded shape of Brown's Yew is perfect for hedges or foundation plantings. Its dark lustrous green foliage is retained beautifully all year. Its slow growth requires very little maintenance. Its unique texture sets it apart from other plants in the landscape with less refined foliage.

## **Capitata Yew**

(Taxus cuspidata 'Capitata') Height: 10-12' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The wonderful Capitata Yew has a naturally compact, dense, and pyramidal growth habit. It will grow quite large if left to grow naturally, but can be kept at just about any height and width through yearly trimming. Aside from a yearly trimming if desired, this variety is extremely low maintenance. Its marvelous deep green color is retained year-round. It can be used for in a very wide variety of landscape applications such as a hedge, privacy screening, foundation planting, or as a stand-alone specimen. A favorite of landscape designers, this yew is very tolerant of harsh urban conditions.

#### Dense Yew

(Taxus x media 'Densiformis') Height: 3-5' Spread: 6-7' Sun/ Part Shade

This lovely, spreading evergreen shrub can be easily pruned to shape or left alone to develop its naturally neat and mounded form. Its rich green foliage is adored year-round and looks beautiful in winter when contrasting with snow that sits atop the shrub. This yew is perfect for hedges and foundation plantings.

## **Everlow Yew**

Taxus x media 'Everlow' Height: 1-1.5' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This low-growing, spreading yew is covered in deep green needles with good color retention throughout the seasons. Hardy and adaptable, it can tolerate a wide variety of soil conditions once established. Avoid wet planting sites. Regular trimming is recommended to encourage dense growth.

## **Hicks Yew**

(Taxus x media 'Hicksii') Height: 10-12' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Hicks Yew is an excellent evergreen shrub for tall hedges and privacy screens. The long, upright-growing branches with dense, glossy, dark green foliage naturally form a narrow, columnar habit that allows this plant to work well as a foundation plant or be placed in pairs at entries. In fall, attractive red berries are greatly enjoyed by birds.

#### Sunburst Yew

(Taxus x media 'Sunburst') Height: 5-7' Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

The Sunburst Yew adds stunning dimension to the landscape with its brilliant contrasting color and texture. Golden foliage emerges in spring and fades to yellow/ light green with age. This spreading yew can be pruned to shape and used as a hedge or left alone to create a softer texture in the landscape.

#### **Baby Gem Boxwood**

(Buxus 'Gregem') Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Baby Gem Boxwood is a dense and tidy broadleaf evergreen. Its shiny foliage adds fine texture to the landscape along with rich evergreen color. This specimen is deer-resistant, disease resistant, drought/heat tolerant, and cold hardy. The Baby Gem Boxwood grows quicker than other varieties. Use this low maintenance shrub as a hedge or foundation planting.

#### Green Gem Boxwood

(Buxus x 'Green Gem') Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Green Gem Boxwood is a lovely specimen commonly used as a hedge or foundation planting. Charming foliage is glossy and emerald green, retaining color year-round. Its small leaves create a fine texture, making it a delicate accent. This specimen is deerresistant, disease resistant, drought/heat tolerant, and cold hardy.

#### **Green Mountain Boxwood**

(Buxus x 'Green Mountain') Height: 5' Spread: 3' Sun/ Part Shade

A more vigorous and upright variety, the Green Mountain Boxwood is the perfect specimen for topiary forms and sculpted hedges. Glossy green foliage creates an attractive, fine texture. Enjoy its rich color year-round. This specimen is deer-resistant, disease resistant, drought/heat tolerant, and cold hardy.

#### **Green Velvet Boxwood**

(Buxus x 'Green Velvet') Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Green Velvet Boxwood is a spreading variety of boxwoods, creating a low and rounded shape. Round green foliage creates an attractive texture and provides color year-round. The Green Velvet Boxwood is a more moderately growing variety of boxwood. This specimen is deer-resistant, disease resistant, drought/heat tolerant, and very cold hardy. It is great for use as a low hedge or foundation planting.

#### Windy City Boxwood

(Buxus x 'Windy City') Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The extremely cold hardy Windy City Boxwood is an excellent choice for creating a low hedge. Glossy green foliage is retained year-round. This shrub adds charming texture and structure to any landscape. The Windy City Boxwood is also deer-resistant, disease-resistant, and drought/heat-tolerant in addition to its cold hardiness.

#### **Emerald Gaiety Euonymous**

(Euonymous fortunei 'Emerald Gaiety') Height: 3-5' Spread: 3-6' Sun/ Part Shade

A stunning broadleaf evergreen, the Emerald Gaiety euonymous is a low, mounded shrub. It is dense and upright with a spreading habit. Deep green leaves with white edges adopt a pinkish tint in winter. Once established, it has good drought tolerance. Use this specimen as a low hedge or border planting.

## **Gold Splash Eunonymous**

(Euonymous fortunei 'Gold Splash') Height & Spread: 18"-2' Sun/ Part Shade

The Gold Splash Euonymous is a smaller variety of euonymous. Rounded foliage is green with yellow borders. This low and mounded evergreen makes an excellent choice for low hedges or border plantings. It is a very versatile specimen and has good drought tolerance once established.

## Moon Shadow Euonymous

(Euonymous fortunei 'Moon Shadow') Height: 3' Spread: 5' Sun/ Part Shade

This rapidly growing evergreen is a stunning way to add contrast to your landscape. Shiny leaves are green with yellow centers, creating the perfect accent with dramatic color. Its mounded form and full appearance are very attractive. It has mild drought tolerance once established. Use this specimen as a low hedge or border plant.

#### Nova Zembla Rhododendron

(Rhododendron x 'Nova Zembla') Height & Spread: 5' Part Sun

The Nova Zembla Rhododendron is a small, dense, and upright, evergreen shrub prized for its large trusses of showy, bright red flowers. It is cold hardy rhododendron, but benefits from protection from winter winds. Flower color develops a deep pink tone in sunnier exposures. It is very useful in foundation plantings or as a landscape accent.

## **Girard's Crimson Azalea**

(Azalea x 'Girards Crimson') Height: 2-4' Spread: 2-3' Part Sun

Beautiful, very large, rosy-red crimson flowers bloom on Girard's Crimson Azalea in spring. Its dense, compact habit with glossy evergreen foliage adds year-round interest. It is a great accent plant for a dappled sun or open shade landscape. This specimen is slow-growing and semi-evergreen. Use this specimen as a hedge or border planting.

#### Girard's Fuschia Azalea

(Azalea x 'Girards Fuschia') Height: 2-4' Spread: 3-5' Part Sun

This hardy Azalea presents a stunning profusion of single, fuchsia-colored blooms that blanket its lush green foliage in spring. It has a compact, mounded habit. This shrub loves dappled sun and is semi-evergreen. Use this specimen as a hedge or border planting.

## Karen Azalea

(Azalea x 'Karens') Height: 2-4 Spread: 3-5' Part Sun

An unusually hardy and highly reliable evergreen shrub with rich lavender-purple flowers, the Karen Azalea is a marvelous specimen. This vigorous, upright plant is showy and colorful. Foliage turns a brilliant burgundy in the fall. It is an ideal spring blooming foundation shrub for beds and borders. This specimen prefers dappled sun and is semi-evergreen.

#### **Rosebud Azalea**

(Azalea x 'Rosebud') Height & Spread: 2-4' Part Sun

This longtime favorite is true to its name, with blooms recalling the classic beauty of roses. Light pink rosebuds open to magnificent rosy pink double flowers in spring. Foliage is a lustrous dark green. This selection is characterized by slow spreading growth and remains neat and tidy in the landscape. It prefers dappled sun and is semi-evergreen.

#### **Berryific Holly**

(Ilex x meserveae 'Berryific') Height: 10-12' Spread: 6-8' Part Sun

Each pot contains a 'Blue Prince' and 'Blue Princess' Holly cultivar for berry formation. This holly is perfect for smaller areas. Its rich evergreen foliage and bright red berries in fall and winter are greatly adored. This specimen is deer-resistant and very attractive to birds.

#### Will & Kate Holly

(Ilex x 'Will & Kate') Height: 10-12' Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

A male and female holly are paired to grow together in the same pot in order to produce berries. Its stunning evergreen foliage is highly admired. This shrub gives way to abundant, brilliant red berries throughout the winter and is adored by wildlife.

## Nordic Inkberry Holly

llez glabra 'Chamzin' Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

This versatile and compact evergreen shrub has a neat, rounded habit of growth. Glossy green, ovate leaves add a coarse texture to the landscape. This shrub requires some maintenance to keep its tidy form. Plant in masses or low borders. If paired with a male cultivar, it will produce black berries that attract wildlife.

## **Roseum Pink Rhododendron**

Rhododendron catawbienese 'Roseum Pink' Height: 5' Spread: 6' Sun/ Part Shade

This hardy, semi-evergreen shrub bursts with cheerful pink flowers in spring. Large, narrow leaves remain dark green and may be evergreen or deciduous depending on the climate. Its upright, spreading habit makes it a handsome choice to create a neat, small hedge.

#### White Catawba Rhododendron

Rhododendron catawbienese 'Album' Height & Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

This stunning cultivar is known for its pure white blooms in early summer. Large, glossy leaves provide an attractive backdrop for these showy blooms. Foliage may be evergreen or deciduous depending on the climate. This versatile shrub is adaptable to a wide range of climates and is very cold hardy. Enchant your landscape and attract pollinators with this specimen.

#### **English Roseum Rhododendron**

Rhododendron x 'English Roseum' Height & Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

This dense and showy shrub graces the garden with large, profuse, dome-shaped clusters of trumpet-like, rosy lilac flowers. Pollinators adore these blooms. Medium-green leaves provide a nice backdrop for its pretty blooms, remaining green and may be evergreen or deciduous depending on the climate. This tough, cold hardy specimen brings elegance to the landscape with ease.

#### PJM Rhododendron

(Rhododendron x 'P.J.M.') Height: 3-6' Spread: 3-7' Part Sun

A durable and charming rhododendron, it produces small trusses of bright lavender-purple blooms that contrast with its small, dark green leaves. The evergreen foliage takes on a mahogany-brown winter color. This variety is noted for its tolerance for heat as well as cold. It is an excellent choice for borders, mass plantings, or containers.

## PJM Elite Rhododendron

(Rhododendron x 'P.J.M. Elite') Height & Spread: 4-5' Part Sun

This rhododendron produces large clusters of frilly, lavender flowers with slight hints of plum in spring. This dense plant is a prolific bloomer and will put on a stunning floral display. The flowers contrast with its glossy, evergreen, elliptical foliage.

# Shrubs & Roses

Our varying selection of shrubs, specially selected for the Midwest landscape, gives you plenty of choices between color, texture, and size.

#### **Admiration Barberry**

(Berberis thunbergii 'Admiration') Height: 12-18" Spread: 18-24" Full Sun

The Admiration Barberry is an award-winning shrub that will light up your garden with its uniquely brilliant foliage and attractive compact form. This dwarf shrub makes a wonderful low-maintenance choice for the landscape. It will light up with petite, cherry-red berries in the fall after its display of precious pink to yellow blooms through summer and into fall.

## **Crimson Pygmy Barberry**

(Berberis thunbergii atropurpurea 'Nana') Height: 2' Spread: 2-3' Full Sun

This dwarf shrub has a handsome, mounded habit. Enjoy its crimson red foliage that adds a pop of color and interesting contrast to the landscape. This excellent accent plant makes a wonderful border planting or low hedge. It is very low-maintenance.

#### Mini Maroon Barberry

(Berberis thunbergii 'NCBT1') Height & Spread: 2-3' Full Sun

This barberry is not invasive and beautifies the landscape without producing the seeds which have made other varieties so problematic. The colorful, care-free barberry offers deep purple-red foliage on a dense, nicely shaped mound. It needs no pruning to stay small and lush, and like all barberries, it is highly resistant to damage from deer and rabbits. It is one of the most easily cared for plants to include in the landscape.

## Sun Joy Neo Barberry

(Berberis thunbergii 'NCBT2') Height & Spread: 2-3' Full Sun

The Sunjoy Neo Barberry boasts vivid orange foliage that stands out in the landscape. No worries about this plant blending into the surroundings, as it is a magnificent burst of eye-catching color. Sun-loving and durable, this barberry is resistant to deer and unbothered by pests and diseases. It naturally grows into a nice, rounded shape that's right at home in the landscape or flower garden.

## **Bobbee Northern Barberry**

(Myrica pensylvanica 'Bobbee') Height & Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Bobbee Northern Barberry is a native semi-evergreen and is both is extremely versatile and hardy. Its dense, rounded, dark green leaves have a fragrance of bay when crushed. The flowers of this barberry appear as inconspicuous, yellowish-green spikes that are found on separate male and female plants. The female flowers, if pollinated, produce a small grayish-white fruit in late summer. This gorgeous shrub may be used along driveways or roadways that require salting during the winter months since the shrub is salt-tolerant.

## **Compact Burning Bush**

(Euonymus alatus 'Compactus') Height: 6-8' Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

This compact shrub with upright branching and interesting bark is sure to make heads turn when it puts on its spectacular show of color in fall. Deep green summer leaves turn fiery-red in the fall. Tiny yellow flowers produce pink fruit that is showy in late fall into winter.

#### **Pipsqueak Burning Bush**

(Euonymus alatus 'Pipzam') Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

The dense, horizontal branching habit of this burning bush makes it a striking shrub for smaller gardens, especially in autumn when the leaves turn crimson red. Add to mixed shrub borders for a display of bright fall color as well as the neat form year-round.

## Sugar Shack Buttonbush

(Cephalanthus occidentalis) Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This shrub is perfect for rain gardens, performing best in moist soils. Buttonbush has long been prized as a native, but it was way too big for most landscapes. This cultivar is half the size and has colorful red fruit and glossy foliage. Fragrant white flowers add on to this delightful plant that shines from spring to fall.

#### Simply Scentsational Sweetshrub

(Calycanthus floridus 'SMNCAF') Height: 6' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

The nicest smelling native, this is the most intriguing scent you'll find in any garden. Admire its gorgeous, velvety, burgundy, magnolia-like flowers that put on a persistent and impressive show from spring into summer. This shrub is both cold hardy and deer-resistant.

# **Black Iroquois Beauty Chokeberry**

(Aronia melanocarpa 'Morton') Height: 3' Spread: 5' Sun/ Part Shade

A multi-stemmed shrub selected for its unique compact habit, its showy display of small white flower clusters, glossy foliage, showy orange to deep-red fall foliage and abundant production of delicious black fruit are enjoyed by both people and wildlife. It is an easy-care shrub for massing in borders, woodlands, and naturalized areas. Ideal planting sites would be near a pond or stream.

## **Brilliant Red Chokeberry**

(Aronia arbutifolia 'Brilliantisima') Height & Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

This improved, compact selection of chokeberry is noted for its lovely white spring flowers followed by larger, more abundant glossy red fruit and brilliant red fall foliage. It is an easy-care, shrub for massing in borders, woodlands and naturalized areas. Ideal planting sites would be near a pond or stream. Its fruit is tart and bitter when eaten fresh and may also be used in preserves.

## Low Scape Mound Chokeberry

(Aronia melanocarpa 'UCONNAM165') Height: 1-2' Spread: 18"-2' Sun/ Part Shade

This low-growing groundcover shrub provides beauty from spring through frost. The Low Scape Mound Chokeberry is a tough, tolerant, and tidy little mound of glossy green foliage. In spring, it's covered in hundreds of dainty white flowers, and in autumn, the leaves turn brilliant red to contrast with dark purple-black fruit. The unique habit of this new variety makes it perfect for mass planting as a ground cover or edging plant. It thrives almost anywhere: cold climates and hot ones, wet soils and dry ones, sun and part shade. This native shrub will gracefully handle just about any landscape challenge you can throw at it.

#### Low Scape Snowfire Chokeberry

Aronia melanocarpa 'SMNAMPEM' Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

This mid-sized native shrub benefits wildlife and beautifies the landscape. Blanketed in little white flowers in spring, it is a delight to pollinators. Autumn brings brilliant red foliage and dark blue fruits that are edible to both people and wildlife. This versatile specimen can be planted almost anywhere in the landscape.

#### Summer Sparkler Summersweet

Clethra alnifolia 'Novacleein' Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

This fragrant shrub blooms through summer, turning heads with its long, loose, weeping wands of white flowers. Butterflies and other pollinators smother its blooms. Foliage is green before turning golden brown in fall. The compact form of this specimen makes it easy to fit into the landscape and to maintain its neat structure.

#### Hummingbird Clethra (Summersweet)

(Clethra alnifolia 'Hummingbird') Height: 2-4' Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Hummingbird Clethra (also known as Summersweet or Sweet Pepper Bush) is a gorgeous, compact, slowly spreading, shrub that eatures bottlebrush spikes of extremely fragrant white flowers which bloom for 4-6 weeks in mid to late summer. Opening from bottom to top, they are very attractive to pollinators. The flowers give way to spikes of dark brown fruits which persist into winter, providing continuing interest. The serrated, glossy, dark green foliage turns golden-yellow in fall.

## **Snow White Fantasy Mock Orange**

Philadelhus 'Snowwhitefanstasy' Height: 5-6' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

This repeat-blooming, versatile shrub presents pure white, fragrant flowers that have a sweet citrus scent. This strong grower's blooms profusely cluster along its branches in spring, and then again in summer. Its upright, rounded form makes this an excellent statement specimen or hedge. Pollinators smother this specimen's blooms.

#### **Candy Coralberry**

(Symphoricarpos x doorenbosii 'Kolmcan') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This is a bright pink winter interest shrub that provides pleasant texture year-round. After dropping its leaves, beautiful pink berries adorn the limbs until late winter. Clip off a stem or two and place them within floral arrangements. This shrub is widely beneficial to pollinators by providing a late-season source of food from its bright pink flowers. Being both cold hardy and heat tolerant, this shrub is quite low maintenance.

#### **Alpine Currant**

(Ribes alpinum) Height & Spread: 3-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The extremely winter hardy Alpine Currant is a compact, mound-forming shrub. The foliage emerges bright green in spring and changes to dark green in summer with an attractive gloss on the leaf uppersides, before turning yellow in the fall. Juicy scarlet berries appear in midsummer on female plants. Perfect for formal or informal hedges as it fills in all the way to the ground. It responds well to heavy pruning or shearing.

## **Green Mound Alpine Currant**

(Ribes alpinum 'Green Mound') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

The Green Mound Alpine Currant is a hardy selection that stays dense and rounded. This shrub will spread to about 2-3' and may get a little taller. Its leaves emerge early, but it retains its rich green foliage all summer long. This shrub is excellent in mass or foundation plantings in the landscape and grows well in the sun or shade. Leaves turn a slight yellow color in fall.

# American Hazelnut

(Corylus americana) Height & Spread: 6-10' Sun/ Part Shade

The American Hazelnut is a thicket-forming native shrub that is excellent for naturalized landscapes, woodland gardens, and shaded areas. Showy catkins add early spring interest and dark green leaves turn a beautiful kaleidoscope of colors in the fall. The nuts mature from September to October, attracting seedeating birds, such as blue jays and woodpeckers.

## **Raspberry Sundae Deutzia**

Deutzia hybrida 'Lowl8' Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

Brighter and larger than other Deitzia, the Raspberry Sundae Deutzia shows off purple-pink flowers that grow along the entirety of its gracefully arching stems. The slightly scented blooms attract pollinators. Compact, low-maintenance, and easy to grow, this specimen is a wonderfully effortless beauty perfect for any landscape.

#### **Chardonnay Pearls Deutzia**

(Deutzia gracillus 'Duncan') Height: 3-4' Spread: 2-3' Sun/Part Shade

Numerous pearl-like buds burst into attractive star-shaped flowers in spring. When flowers have faded, this plant continues to shine with its bright yellow foliage. Growth is strong but compact to create a wonderful small shrub that is equally at home in the shrub border as it is in a perennial one. It adds stunning color and vibrancy to any landscape.

## Yuki Cherry Blossom Deutzia

(Deutzia x 'NCDK2') Height & Spread: 2' Sun/ Part Shade

Perfectly pretty pink flowers cloak this deutzia. A shower of elegant pink flowers creates a lovey feature in the landscape. Great for mass plantings because of its neat, mounded habit and burgundy-purple fall color, this tough, adaptable plant makes an excellent groundcover, especially on a sunny slope.

#### **Cranberry Cotoneaster**

Cotoneaster apiculatus Height: 2-3' Spread: 3-6' Full Sun

This spreading shrub makes an excellent groundcover, as it is highly adaptable. It also performs great as a low hedge, creating impenetrable tangles with its stiffly arched branches. Glossy green foliage turns hues of purple, red, and bronze in fall. Small pink spring flowers give way to cranberry-like berries that persist into winter and are enjoyed by wildlife.

## **Purpleleaf Bailey Select Filbert**

(Corylus americana 'Purpleleaf Bailey Select') Height & Spread: 7-8' Sun/ Part Shade

The Purpleleaf Bailey Select American Hazelnut is prized for its delicious edible nuts and unbeatable ornamental appearance. It has splendid burgundy foliage that slowly and subtly transforms to green with wine-colored overtones. The edible nuts grow in clusters of two to four and will ripen in time for roasting in the fall. Wildlife are very attracted to this shrub.

## **Cool Splash Diervilla**

Diervilla sessilifolia 'LPDC PODARAS' Height & Spread: 2.5-4.5' Sun/ Part Shade

This densely branched shrub displays gorgeous foliage with bright white leaf margins. The white margins turn pink for a colorful fall display. Bunches of yellow blooms attract pollinators in summer. It is both drought and deer-resistant. Fit this gorgeous plant in the landscape by using it in low borders or mass plantings.

# Kodiak Fresh Diervilla

(Diervilla x 'SMNDSS') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This durable native plant will thrive in sun or shade, and is both drought-tolerant and deer-resistant. It gives a new look to diervilla with its bright lime-yellow foliage in summertime, always accompanied by bright yellow flowers. Like the other members of the Kodiak series, it lights up the fall landscape with its orange glow, mak- ing it a great alternative to burning bush. This is an excellent plant that will succeed in even challenging sites.

## **Nightglow Diervilla**

(Diervilla splendens 'El Madrigal') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This diervilla has dark, moody burgundy foliage that becomes more vivid in the fall. The high-contrast flowers in yellow are trumpet shaped and frequented by both butterflies and bees. This tough little shrub flowers from spring to summer and looks amazing next to plants with chartreuse or golden foliage. This is an upright multi-stemmed shrub with a mounding form. It is usually ignored by deer and is tolerant of dry and clay sites. It is small and compact, working well in foundation plantings for a pop of color, as a low hedge, and in containers.

## Orange Kodiak Diervilla

(Diervilla 'Kodiak Orange') Height: 3-4' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

A tough native flowering shrub that makes a bold statement in the fall landscape with its glowing orange fall foliage, this is an excellent choice that will create high contrast in the landscape. Pollinators adore the little flowers that this shrub provides spring through summer. This drought tolerant shrub thrives in sun or shade and is adaptable to most soils.

# Red Kodiak Diervilla

(Diervilla 'Kodiak Red') Height: 3-4' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Kodiak Red Diervilla is a native flowering shrub that looks great while shrugging off shade, varying soils, and even deer. New growth emerges in spring with a rich red tone, and turns vivid red in fall. This shrub is adored by pollinators for its small flowers that last from spring through summer. It is a spectacular specimen, especially in fall, never failing to provide intense contrast.

## **Bailey Redtwig Dogwood**

(Cornus sericea 'Baileyi') Height & Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

The Bailey Red Twig Dogwood has attractive red stems in winter and hands down the reddest stemmed variety of dogwood by far. Flat clus- ters of white flowers bloom around late spring through summer and transform into tiny plump blue fruit. This dogwood's fruits will attract birds to your garden. It will tolerate some shade and moisture. Like most dogwoods, remove old stems to the ground for the best stem color each spring.

#### **Bergeson Dogwood**

(Cornus sericea 'Bergeson Compact') Height & Spread: 4-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The Bergeson Compact Dogwood is notable for its rich, red stems in winter and its compact habit. Small white flowers bloom in late spring followed by white to pale blue drupes that appear in mid-summer and are beloved by birds. Like most dogwoods, remove old stems to the ground for the best stem color each spring.

# Ivory Halo Dogwood

(Cornus alba 'Bailhalo') Height & Spread: 5' Sun/ Part Shade

Prized for its colorful stems, variegated foliage, and compact size, this dwarf dogwood has brilliant red winter stems and showy, light green leaves with creamy white margins, but at only twothirds the size of many of its species. Cream-white flowers intermittently bloom and sparsely adorn this shrub. Use it to provide multi-season interest in shrub borders, mass plantings, or as a low hedge. Remove old stems to the ground for the best stem color each spring.

## **Red Gnome Dogwood**

(Cornus alba 'Regnzam') Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Red Gnome, is a compact cultivar that typically grows in a rounded mound. Dark green foliage retains good color throughout the growing season before turning burgundy in fall. Creamy white flowers bloom in clusters at the branch ends in late spring. White berries mature in mid-summer and attract birds. Bright red stems are particularly attractive in winter against a snowy backdrop. Like with most dogwoods, remove old stems to the ground for the best stem color each spring.

#### Red Rover Dogwood

(Cornus obliqua 'Powell Gardens') Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Exceptional fall foliage is the hallmark of this compact selection. Green foliage contrasts nicely with white flowers in summer, and autumn brings deep purple foliage, gradually turning luminous red. Flowers are great for pollinators, fall fruit similarly for songbirds. It is an outstanding plant for moist to damp sites with its compact size being ideal for residential landscapes. Like most Dogwoods, remove old stems to the ground for the best stem color each spring.

## Muskingum Gray Dogwood

Cornus racemosa 'Muszam' Height: 2-3' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This compact Dogwood provides an exceptional multi-season display. Its short form has a spreading habit, making it a great low hedge. Bronze-red foliage emerges in spring, maturing to grayish-green. Delicate, creamy flower clusters adorn this shrub and have a sweet lilac fragrance. Fall foliage is rich red and is contrasted by the showy white berries that are loved by birds.

## Lemon Lace Elderberry

(Sambucus racemosa 'SMNSRD4') Height & Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Noted for its golden foliage, this elderberry is a compact shrub adorned with a luminous lacy foliage of deeply dissected leaves. Emerging bright yellow with red edges in spring, the foliage turns attractive chartreuse and forms a dense, irregular mound of extremely fine texture. In mid-spring, abundant clusters of white flowers are produced before the leaves. They give way to red fruit that attracts birds in the fall. Colorful from spring through fall, this easy-to-grow shrub looks wonderful in mixed borders or as a high-impact specimen plant.

## Show Off Forsythia

(Forsythia x intermedia 'Mindor') Height & Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The Show Off Forsythia puts on a brilliant show of stunning yellow early spring flowers. It has an improved flower display compared to older varieties and is excellent for floral arrangements. It is handsome and compact, making it very low-maintenance. This shrub has good urban tolerance, is heat-tolerant once established, and is deer-resistant.

## **Dwarf Fothergilla**

(Fothergilla gardenii) Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

The Dwarf Fothergilla is a valuable, compact ornamental shrub used for hedges and borders to provide multi-season interest in the landscape. Fragrant, creamy white, fuzzy, bottlebrush flowers cover the low, mounded, dense form in spring, followed by thick, toothy blue-green leaves in summer. Fall foliage is a brilliant medley of yellow, red, and orange.

# Legend of the Small Fothergilla

(Fothergilla x intermedia) Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This nifty little native provides three seasons of interest. The Legend of the Small Fothergilla flowers abundantly in the spring, providing pollinators a reliable source of nectar early in the season. In summer, its foliage is bluish-green until it erupts into fantastic red-orange fall color. This variety is very shade-tolerant and is also deer-resistant.

# Mt Airy Fothergilla

Fothergilla x intermedia 'Mount Airy' Height & Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

A recipient of the Award of Garden Merit, the Mt Airy Fothergilla is admired for its profusion of honey-scented, bottle-brush-like, white spring flowers. Leathery green foliage turns fabulous shades of purple, yellow, and orange. It prefers as much sun as possible, but can tolerate light shade.

## Annabelle Hydrangea

(Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle') Height: 4-5' Spread: 4-6' Part Shade

Annabelle is the best known variety of hydrangea, prized for its hardiness and stunning white flowers, often producing heads over 10" in diameter. Annabelle blooms every year even after severe pruning or intensely cold winters.

#### Azure Skies Hydrangea

(Hydrangea macrophylla 'COF HM1') Height & Spread: 5-6' Part Shade

This reblooming hydrangea produces an incredible display of large mophead-type blossoms that will be pink or blue depending on soil pH. The beautiful blossoms make excellent cut flowers for bringing indoors, and they are long-lasting. The heaviest blooming is in summer, but it will continue into early fall.

#### **BloomStruck Hydrangea**

(Hydrangea macrophylla 'P11HM-11') Height: 3-4' Spread: 4-5' Part Shade

The BloomStruck Hydrangea produces large three to five-inch diameter, mophead-style flower heads with attractive reddish-purple branches and dark-green leaves. Flower color can range as very acidic soil results in blue blooms and soil that is less acidic results in purple blooms or blooms with a reddish hue.

#### Bobo Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'llvobo') Height: 3' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Bobo Hydrangea is engulfed by large white flowers in summer. The flowers are held upright on strong stems, and continue to grow and lengthen as they bloom. As blooms age, they turn pink. It is compact and dwarf in habit, and the flowers cover every inch of the plant right down to the ground.

#### Fire and Ice Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'Wims Red') Height: 3-6' Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Fire and Ice Hydrangea presents a parade of color. Cold hardy and easy to care for, its creamy white flowers appear in early spring, contrasting nicely against the bright green foliage. By midsummer, the flowers are a soft pink, and they continue to deepen to a burgundy red by fall.

#### Fire Light Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMHPFL') Height: 6-8' Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The Fire Light Hydrangea is a compact, early blooming, heat-tolerant selection with attractive greenish-red foliage all season. It blooms creamy white in early summer, turns pink in mid-summer, and becomes deep red in fall.

#### Fire Light Tidbit Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMN4PK') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

The Fire Light Tidbit Hydrangea blooms in mid-summer. The flowers start white and develop their pink coloration beginning in late August when the weather gets cooler. Its gorgeous blooms cover the compact form from top to bottom.

#### Flare Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'Kolmavesu') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

Add some showy flair to your outdoor space with the Flare Hydrangea. White flowers bloom in cone-shaped clusters that are wide at the bottom and narrow near the top. They gradually fade into a vibrant shade of reddish-pink starting at the bottom of the cluster and working up to the tip. Woody stems support the flowers and broad green foliage.

#### Incrediball Hydrangea

(Hydrangea arborescens 'Incrediball') Height & Spread: 4-5' Part Shade

This adaptable native plant produces huge flowers (as large as 12 inches wide) and is both reliable and beautiful. Incrediball blooms on new growth so even very cold winters won't keep it from blooming. It is an improved version of the classic Annabelle Hydrangea, but with strong, sturdy stems that don't flop over. White flowers begin to appear in mid-summer and open to enormous snowballs, nearly the size of basketballs. They then age to a lush jade green, which persists through frost.

#### Invincibelle Wee White Hydrangea

(Hydrangea aborescens 'NCHA5') Height & Spread: 1-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This is the first dwarf Annabelle-type hydrangea in the world. This cute little landscape plant ensures that any landscape can enjoy the reliability, low-maintenance, and season-long beauty of hydrangeas. It naturally grows as a tidy, rounded mound. Each flower emerges a soft, blush pink before changing to white, and is held up on a strong, supportive stem for a display that looks more like a bouquet of flowers than a landscape plant. Blooming begins in early summer and continues through frost.

#### Invincible Ruby Hydrangea

(Hydrangea arborescens 'NCHA3') Height: 4-5' Spread: 4-6' Part Shade

The dark burgundy red flower buds of the Invincibelle Ruby open to a two-toned combination of bright ruby red and silvery pink. The foliage is extra dark and stems are strong, making this new hydrangea a gem in any garden.

#### Limelight Prime Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMNHPPK') Height: 4-6' Spread: 4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Limelight Prime is an improved, more refined Limelight with darker leaves, stronger stems, a more compact habit, and upright growth. Makes a great container plant. Blooms emerge a vivid lime-green and maintain that color until they transition into a bubblegum pink and a deep punch pink. It is drought-tolerant once established.

#### Little Hottie Hydrangea

(Hydrangea panticulata 'Bailpanone') Height & Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This little hydrangea is extremely compact with great branching. Deep green leaves are a beautiful backdrop for the late summer flowers that are held up on strong and sturdy stems. Forming in a tight cluster, the blossoms are initially green and open to a creamy white. As temperatures drop in the fall, the petals turn shades of white and pink. The small size, reduced need for pruning, and large flowers make this an ideal choice for smaller landscapes.

#### Little Lime Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'Jane') Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

A new dwarf form of the ever popular Limelight Hydrangea, Little Lime produces the same great flowers and coloration but in a smaller package. Gorgeous lime-green flowers mature to a rich deep pink. It has a compact habit and strong stems.

#### Little Lime Punch Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMNHPH') Height & Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Drink in the beauty of the Little Lime Punch Hydrangea all season long. Similar to Little Lime, its blooms emerge lime-green, but they mature a little differently. Flowers change progressively from the bottom up in a gorgeous array of white, light pink, and rich punch red. Reblooming throughout the summer, you'll see these four colors mix to create a truly memorable show. It has a compact habit and strong stems.

# Little Quick Fire Hydrangea

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMHPLQF') Height & Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This wonderful dwarf form hydrangea is early blooming. White flowers transform to pinkish-red as summer progresses. Its compact size fits easily into any landscape.

#### Alice Oakleaf Hydrangea

(Hydrangea quercifolia 'Alice') Height & Spread: 5-8' Sun/ Part Shade

This hydrangea's uniquely-shaped flowers bloom white and turn pink as they mature. Its large leaves boast rich purple and red hues during autumn, provding marvelous contrast. This type is more shade-tolerant.

#### Munchkin Oakleaf Hydrangea

(Hydrangea quercifolia 'Munchkin') Height & Spread: 3-4' Part Shade

This bite-size Hydrangea was developed by the U.S. National Arboretum. It provides a profusion of beautiful, large flower heads that emerge white and age to a delicate pink. Dark green foliage transforms into a magnificent mahogany color in fall. The compact form of this variety makes it a greatly adored favorite in shaded gardens.

# Popstar Bigleaf Hydrangea

(Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmacsix') Height & Spread: 18"-3' Part Shade

The Pop Star Hydrangea is a lacecap variety that stands out in the landscape. Its short stature makes this a strong border or short hedge that doesn't need pruning to keep its size. The dark green leaves against the blue or pink blooms give the classic hydrangea look, while the lacecap flowers add extra texture and interest to the garden.

#### Eclipse Hydrangea

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Eclipse' Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

The Eclipse Hydrangea is the first to hold dark color all season. It also offers outstanding disease resistance. Its impressive flower cones are hot pink with chartreuse centers. They make wonderful cut flowers. This Hydrangea's great disease resistance maintains a clean, healthy look with little maintenance.

#### Gatsby Gal Oakleaf Hydrangea

Hydrangea quercifolia 'Brenhill' Height & Spread: 4-6' Sun/ Part Shade

Large, deep green leaves cover this shrub's compact and rounded form. Full panicles of pure white blooms are held upright above the foliage. Leaves turn wine red in fall. This elegant specimen is a great addition to smaller landscapes, packing tons of interest into this gorgeous showstopper.

#### Gatsby Pink Oakleaf Hydrangea

(Hydrangea quercifolia 'JoAnn') Height & Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

This gorgeous specimen boasts big, showy blooms that quickly transform from pure white to pink, providing months of color. Dark green foliage turns burgundy-red in fall. Add unique elegance to your landscape with this eye-catching Hydrangea.

#### **Quick Fire Fab Hydrangea**

(Hydrangea paniculata 'SMNHPM') Height: 6-8' Spread: 5-6' Sun/ Part Shade

The Quick Fire Fab shares the same super-early bloom time, rock-solid reliability, and easy-going nature of the original Quick Fire hydrangea, but adds big, full, showy mophead blooms to the mix. As the blooms age, they turn blush pink, then bright pink, then red, from the bottom up, making each one look like a big delicious ice cream cone that goes from vanilla to berry as the summer progresses.

#### Ruby Slippers Oak Leaf Hydrangea

(Hydrangea quercifolia 'Ruby Slippers') Height: 3-4' Spread: 3-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Ruby Slippers is noted for its compact size, large upright flower panicles, ruby red mature flowers, mahogany red fall foliage, and exfoliating bark. Upright, elongated, conical flower panicles (up to to 9" long) of showy flowers begin bloom in late spring. Flowers emerge white, but quickly turn pink before finally maturing to ruby red. Distinctive, deeply-lobed, deep green, oak-like leaves turn attractive shades of mahagony-red in autumn. Mature stems exfoliate to reveal a brown inner bark that is attractive in winter.

#### Summer Crush Hydrangea

(Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmacfive') Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

The Summer Crush Hydrangea provides rich raspberry red hues, the nearest to true red that any hydrangea has ever been in US soil. A gorgeous, impressively heat-tolerant plant, it is a show-stopping accent in the landscape. Rich green, serrated foliage fills out a compact habit. This cultivar is extremely bud hardy, so it will reliably bloom on both old and new wood.

# Tiny Tuff Stuff Hydrangea

(Hydrangea serrata 'MAKD') Height & Spread: 18"-2' Sun/ Part Shade

A very hardy reblooming Hydrangea, this is a real beauty. Extremely bud-hardy, each year it produces abundant lacecap flowers comprised of doubled sepals. It is a rebloomer. While this plant leans to blue, the flower color may range from blue to pink to white, all soft, delicate shades. Flowers age to an attractive pink, and tip down in a distinctive arching fashion. It has smaller, narrower leaves and an abundance of dainty flowers that cover the plant every summer.

# Ah-Ha Tuff Stuff Hydrangea

(Hydrangea serrata 'SMNHSDD') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

All summer long, it devotes its energies to creating flower buds on its new growth so that you have a constant supply of fabulous blooms from early summer through frost. The Tuff Stuff Ah-Ha Hydrangea will bloom pink or blue, depending on soil chemistry.

#### Red Tuff Stuff Hydrangea

(Hydrangea serrata 'SMNMAKTSR') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

Red is a new color for the Tuff Stuff series. This hydrangea offers improved bud and stem hardiness, reblooming habit, and the double-lacecap flowers of the original, but Tuff Stuff Red brings with it magnificent, dark reddish-pink flowers.

# Berry White Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata 'Renba' Height: 6-7' Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This impressive Hydrangea holds its white, cone-shaped flowers upright on its sturdy structure. Blooms shift to a gorgeous reddish-pink. This shrub is extremely winter-hardy. Use this specimen as a natural screen that provides both beauty and privacy.

#### Pufferfish Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata 'NCHP1' Height & Spread: 3-5 Sun/ Part Shade

This magical Hydrangea brings a soft texture to the landscape when completely engulfed in large, puffed up, white flower cones. Blooms turn lime green with age. Its tight, compact habit is constructed of sturdy stems that hold the flower cones upright. This tidy specimen works wonderfully as a low border or hedge.

# Fizzy Mini Sweetspire

(Itea virginica 'SMNIVMM') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This stunning sweetspire literally stands out in the landscape. Its abundant upright flower spikes are bright white and carry a light, lovely fragrance that attracts people and pollinators. An early summer bloom time helps bridge the gap between the seasons seamlessly and its thick, dark green foliage is handsome enough to carry the show for the rest of the season. With a petite size, you'll be able to use it in any size landscape.

# Little Henry Sweetspire

(Itea virginica 'Sprich') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This sweetspire is native to North America with lots of potential for the home landscape. It prefers moist soils and will tolerate wet conditions. It will grow in full sun to full shade, and requires little pruning or other maintenance. It has lightly scented, pure white flowers that shoot up like fireworks in the early summer. Its mounded, compact stature is very attractive. Green summer foliage changes to a brilliant array of oranges and reds in the fall.

#### **Baby Kim Lilac**

(Syringa x 'SMNSDTP') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

Enjoy a delightfully fragrant lilac that fits almost anywhere in the landscape. Adore its glossy, dark green foliage, an abundance of fragrant purple blooms that don't fade to white, and a useful rounded habit that fits into just about any sunny spot. It brings all the joy of lilacs into a neater, tidier package so you can enjoy this classic flowering shrub no matter how much or how little space you have. It is rarely bothered by deer.

# **Beauty of Moscow Lilac**

(Syringa vulgaris 'Beauty of Moscow') Height: 8-12' Spread: 6-7' Full Sun

Noted for its unique color, the Beauty of Moscow Lilac produces showy upright panicles of highly fragrant, double flowers in late spring. Opening from pinkish-lilac buds, the double white florets are adorned with a very pale pink blush, creating a stunning bicolor effect. The open branches are clothed in light green, heart-shaped leaves that remain attractive in summer. Foliage is generally resistant to powdery mildew.

#### **Dark Purple Bloomerang Lilac**

(Syringa x 'Penda') Height: 5-7' Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

Enjoy months of blooms instead of just weeks with the Dark Purple Bloomerang Lilac. Its flowers are big, bold, and beautiful. Naturally growing as a handsome, rounded shrub, very large dark purple buds emerge in mid to late spring. These open to a deep purple-lilac color and perfume the air for weeks. The plant then takes a brief rest to create new growth before it starts to bloom again in mid to late summer, continuing through frost. The Bloomerang Lilac is also noted for its exceptional disease resistance. Cut and bring indoors to enjoy their fragrance at all times.

#### **Common Purple Lilac**

(Syringa vulgaris) Height & Spread: 8-10' Full Sun

Abundant clusters of sweetly fragrant, purple flowers emerge in mid-spring on this vigorous, upright, multi-stemmed shrub. It has charming heart-shaped, green foliage. It can be used as a flowering hedge or screen. Plant near a window or pathway where the fragrant blooms can be enjoyed. Cut and bring indoors to enjoy their fragrance at all times.

#### **Common White Lilac**

(Syringa vulgaris var. 'Alba') Height & Spread: 10-12' Full Sun

The Common White Lilac is richly scented and has single cream-white flowers that bloom lovely and pair well with its light blue-green foliage. The Common White Lilac is very similar to the Common Purple lilac, making it an excellent informal screen or hedge in the landscape. These also make for wonderful cut flowers.

#### **Dwarf Korean Lilac**

(Syringa meyeri 'Palabin') Height: 4-5' Spread: 5-7' Full Sun

Dwarf Korean Lilac flowers heavily in mid to late spring, with dense clusters of tiny tubular pink flowers. The flowers buds are a handsome purple, making this lilac bush attractive just before it blooms, too. The leaves are much smaller and cleaner than those of other lilacs bushes. Its compact, rounded shape, and resistance to powdery mildew make this a treasured variety of lilac.

#### Ludwig Spaeth Lilac

(Syringa vulgaris 'Ludwig Spaeth') Height: 6-10' Spread: 6-8' Full Sun

Beautiful, heavily fragrant, reddish-purple, single blooms emerge late in spring, extending the lilac season. Its open branches are clothed in light green, heart-shaped leaves that remain attractive in summer. This outstanding selection is useful in mixed shrub borders or in mass plantings with other lilacs. It is rarely to never fed on by Japanese Beetles.

#### Madame Lemoine Lilac

(Syringa vulgaris 'Madame Lemoine') Height: 8-10' Spread: 9-10' Full Sun

Regarded as one of the best white lilacs, the award-winning Madame Lemoine Lilac is an upright shrub with large, showy panicles packed with amazingly fragrant, double, white flowers. Opening from creamy buds in late spring, the abundant blossoms last 3-4 weeks and make a wonderful display of glistening white. The erect, open branches are clothed in light green, heart-shaped leaves that remain attractive in summer.

#### **Miss Kim Lilac**

(Syringa patula 'Miss Kim') Height & Spread: 6-8' Full Sun

This upright, compact lilac blooms later than others, extending the season with rich deep purple buds that reveal clusters of lovely lavender blue flowers. Foliage is burgundy in fall. This lilac is great for border accents or mass planting.

#### **President Grevy Lilac**

(Syringa vulgaris 'President Grevy') Height: 10-12' Spread: 7-8' Full Sun

The vigorous President Grevy Lilac is an upright shrub with immense panicles packed with highly fragrant, double lavenderblue florets in late spring. The open branches are clothed in light green, heart-shaped leaves that remain attractive in summer. Introduced in 1886, this French lilac remains as popular as ever and is perfect for sunny mixed borders.

# **Sensation Lilac**

(Syringa vulgaris 'Sensation') Height & Spread: 8-10' Full Sun

The highly popular, award-winning Sensation Lilac is an upright shrub noted for its unusual bicolor flowers. Sweetly scented, they form large, pyramidal panicles of purplish-red florets adorned with white edges. Blooming in late spring, the blossoms are so profuse that they literally cover the plant. The erect, open branches are clothed in rich green, heart-shaped leaves that remain attractive in summer.

# Violet Uprising Lilac

Syringa patula 'Jn Upright Select A' Height: 4-6' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

This upright form of Manchurian Lilac has a smaller, more compact form than others. Profuse, light purple flowers are slightly scented and attract pollinators. Medium green foliage turns purple in fall. Use this specimen as a handsome hedge. Pollinators adore this plant.

#### **Pearl Potion Lilac**

Syringa meyeri 'JDB123Whitehouse' Height: 5' Spread: 7' Full Sun

Pearl Potion is a highly versatile, neat, and compact variety of Lilac that is deer-resistant. Tiny, starry, pink flowers appear in mid-spring, maturing to pearl white. Medium green foliage covers the tidy structure of this specimen. Pollinators adore this lilac and deer tend to not care for it.

#### Scentara Double Blue Lilac

Syringa x hyacinthflora 'SMNSHBBL' Height & Spread: 6-8' Full Sun

The most fragrant Proven Winners Lilac yet, Scentara Double Blue is a heavy bloomer full of intricate, blue-purple, doubled florets. Its handsome, upright form is covered in medium-green foliage. Pollinators are very attracted to this specimen. This shrub shows excellent disease resistance and it is also deer-resistant.

#### Lucky Devil Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Zlemichael' Height & Width: 3-4' Full Sun

This drought-tolerant shrub serves as a spectacular focal point. Brilliant yellow foliage turns orange in fall. Beautiful white blooms emerge in spring, attracting pollinators. This plant looks wonderful planted in masses or as an informal hedge.

#### Summer Wine Black Ninebark

Physocarpus opufolius 'SMNPMS' Height & Spread: 5-6' Full Sun

This Ninebark has the darkest most dramatic foliage yet. Spring brings white flowers that contrast the nearly black foliage. Its upright stems and small foliage adds attractive fine texture to the landscape. This shrub is low-maintenance and easy to grow.

# **Ginger Wine Ninebark**

(Physocarpus opulifolius 'SMPOBLR) Height: 5-6' Spread: 4-5' Full Sun

This fuss-free, low-maintenance shrub creates a stunning backdrop in shrub borders. Spring foliage emerges radiant orange before transforming into a sparkling burgundy color. Unique peeling bark provides year-round interest, especially in winter as it contrasts with the snow.

#### **Panther Ninebark**

(Physocarpus opulifolius 'Panther') Height: 4-5' Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

The Panther Ninebark is a stealthy shrub that lures attention no matter where it is in the landscape. In the summer it blooms sparse, pink flowers that pop against its sleek black foliage and stems, creating the ultimate contrast. Its resilience and compact size make it a unique, easy to grow choice for modern landscapes.

#### **Tiny Wine Ninebark**

(Physocarpus opulifolius 'SMPOTW') Height: 3-4' Spread: 3' Full Sun

This dwarf variety of ninebark is densely covered with small, refined leaves. Marvelous dark maroon foliage is colorful all season and contrasts with pretty white flowers in late spring. The foliage color in fall is a nice bright yellow color. This shrub also is great for winter interest because of the peeling bark and dried flowers that persist into winter.

# **Northern Spicebush**

(Lindera benzoin) Height & Spread: 6-12' Sun/ Part Shade

The Northern Spicebush is a multi-stemmed, rounded shrub noted for its early flowers, red berries, and excellent fall color. Its graceful branches are studded with dense clusters of sweetly fragrant, tiny, pale yellow flowers in early-mid spring. Blooming before the leaves unfurl, the blossoms attract pollinators. The flowers are followed by bright glossy red berries which mature in fall and are attractive to wildlife. Its thick, pale green leaves turn golden-yellow in fall. Both the fruit and foliage are aromatic, emitting a spicy fragrance when bruised. Fast-growing and easy to grow, this native shrub is a fine choice for moist, shady places or naturalized landscapes.

#### New Jersey Tea

(Ceanothus americanus) Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

New Jersey Tea features glossy leaves, numerous clusters of bright white flowers and a mounding shape that make this compact shrub a popular choice as an attractive low growing hedge and is an excellent choice for rocky hillsides and slopes, as well. It requires a well-drained site and it is very drought tolerant once established.

# Mandarin Tango Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'Jefman' Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

A tough and compact shrub, it is deer-resistant and low-maintenance. Soft orange blooms are nonstop from spring to frost. Fine textured, green foliage contrasts nicely with more coarsely textured shrubs. Pollinators love this plant.

#### Happy Face White Potentilla

Potentilla fruticosa 'White Lady' Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This durable shrub offers profuse white blooms from spring to frost. This deer-resistant specimen has small green foliage that contrasts nicely with more coarsely textured shrubs. Pollinators love this plant.

#### **Happy Face Yellow Potentilla**

Potentilla fruticosa 'Lundy' Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

Enjoy this shrub's nonstop yellow blooms from spring to frost. It is highly durable and deer-resistant. Its small green foliage brings a very fine texture to the landscape contrasting nicely with more coarsely textured shrubs. Pollinators love this plant.

#### **Pink Beauty Potentilla**

Potentilla fruticosa <sup>'</sup>Pink Beauty' Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

Profuse pink flowers smother this bushy shrub from late spring until the first frost, continuously adding pops of color to the landscape. This tough plant is highly drought-resistant and deer-resistant. It looks wonderful planted masses or borders.

#### **Goldfinger Potentilla**

(Potentilla fruticosa 'Goldfinger') Height: 2-4' Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This profusely flowering shrub grows into a small, dense, and rounded form. Cheerful, bright yellow, long-lasting flowers are enjoyed from mid-summer to early fall. Pollinators are very attracted to this specimen.

#### **Cheyenne Privet**

(Ligustrum vulgare 'Cheyenne') Height: 8-10' Spread: 4-6' Sun/ Part Shade

Cheyenne Privet is an adaptable and low maintenance shrub once established. It can tolerate heavy pruning and shearing, making it an ideal candidate for a formal hedge or screen. Glossy green leaves turn yellow in the fall. Small clusters of white flowers bloom in early summer. It can tolerate a wide variety of soil conditions, but avoid wet sites.

#### Fuji Rose of Sharon

(Hibiscus syriacus 'Minspot') Height: 5-8' Spread: 4-7' Full Sun

This charming Rose of Sharon is an upright, vase-shaped shrub noted for its semi-double, trumpet-shaped, pink flowers adorned with a bold crimson throat. Blooming from midsummer to early fall, the blossoms slowly fade to pale pink. Each flower lasts about one day and stands out against the green foliage of maple-like leaves. This is a very useful, structural shrub for foundation plantings. This specimen is highly drought tolerant.

#### Lil Kim Rose of Sharon

(Hibiscus syriacus 'Antong Two') Height & Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

This dwarf Rose of Sharon is about half the size of a conventional rose of Sharon. It grows in an elegant, refined habit. Each stem is packed with pretty flower buds that open to reveal stunning white flowers with a showy red eye. This specimen is salt-tolerant and highly drought-tolerant.

#### Minerva Rose of Sharon

(Hibiscus syriacus 'Minerva') Height: 10' Spread: 6' Sun/ Part Shade

This compact shrub is highly valued for abundance of continuous flowers with a longer bloom season and little to no seed production. Lavender flowers have a pink overlay and dark red eye. It has a dense habit of handsome, leathery, dark green foliage that creates a wonderful informal hedge or screen. This specimen is highly tolerant of air pollution and drought.

# Purpleleaf Sandcherry

(Prunus x cistena) Height: 7-10' Spread: 5-7' Sun/ Part Shade

The Purpleleaf Sandcherry is a very hardy, flowering landscape specimen with reddish-purple foliage that keeps its unique color all summer and turns a beautiful bronzed-green in fall. Because of this, it provides long-lived, excellent contrast in the landscape. It produces fragrant light pink to white flowers from late April to early May.

# **Royal Purple Smokebush**

(Cotinus coggygria 'Royal Purple') Height & Spread: 8-10' Full Sun

The award-winning Royal Purple Smokebush is a bushy and large shrub noted for its attractive foliage of rounded leaves. Emerging rich maroon-red in spring, the leaves mature to deep wine purple in summer, before turning redder in fall. Appearing in late spring, large, feathery, pink flower plumes cover the plant with fluffy, hazy "smoky" puffs throughout summer. When viewed en masse, these have a wispy 'smoke-like' appearance, hence the common name smokebush. This is truly a spectacular accent shrub with a very long season of interest.

# Velvet Cloak Smokebush

Cotinus coggygria 'Velvet Cloak' Height: 10-15' Spread: 15-20 Sun/ Part Shade

This large, bushy shrub is adored for its long season of interest and unique foliage. Maroon-red, ovate leaves mature to deep red-purple in late summer before a display of brilliant red takes over. Feathery pink flower plumes crown the top of this shrub in summer, appearing like smoke when viewed from afar. This eyecatching specimen creates highly ornamental hedges.

# **Rainbow Fizz Spirea**

Spiraea japonica 'Matgold' Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

Rainbow Fizz brings a burst of color to the landscape. This coldhardy Spirea is ready to amaze with its ever changing color display. New, reddish-pink foliage matures to lime green, accented by reddish-pink stems. Late spring brings hot pink flower clusters that pollinators smother as they persist all the way to fall. The last show of color comes with cooler temperatures, turning to incredible coppery-red.

# **Double Play Dolly Spirea**

Spiraea x 'SMNSJSA' Height & Spread: 18-30' Sun/ Part Shade

Bring blazing color to your landscape with this Spirea. New foliage emerges orange-red and matures to chartreuse in late spring. Electric purple blooms contrast its foliage nicely. Its small habit fits wonderfully in the landscape as a low hedge or border. Pollinators are very attracted to this specimen.

# **Double Play Artisan Spirea**

(Spiraea japonica 'Galen') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

In addition to its vibrant pink summer flowers, the Double Play Artisan Spirea has rich purple-red new growth in spring. You'll get months of vibrant color from this adaptable, drought-tolerant, easy to grow plant. It maintains its compact, mounded shape with very little pruning, and has more vivid color than other spirea varieties.

# Double Play Big Bang Spirea

(Spiraea x 'Tracy') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

Durable, super easy to care for, and producing perfectly pretty pink flowers in spring, this spirea is one of the finest varieties. It has the biggest, pinkest flowers of any Japanese spirea. It also offers super colorful new growth, especially when it emerges in early spring. It is drought-tolerant, grows and blooms well in partial shade, and maintains a nice, neat shape without pruning.

#### **Double Play Candy Corn Spirea**

(Spiraea japonica 'NCSX1') Height: 2' Spread: 3' Full Sun

This stunning spirea delivers a thrilling series of color. Bright candy apple red foliage emerges in spring and matures to a bold yellow, with a continuous topping of blazing orange all season long. It delivers an additional burst of color with its vibrant, red-violet blooms. It is drought-tolerant and requires no pruning.

#### **Double Play Gold Spirea**

(Spiraea japonica 'Yan') Height: 18"-2' Spread: 16"-2' Sun/ Part Shade

Hot pink flower clusters rise above the bright gold foliage of the compact Double Play Gold Spirea. The season-long color begins as the leaves emerge each spring and flowers join the color burst in summer. The bright yellow foliage alone makes this spirea a unique complement to green-leafed plants in the landscape. This specimen is drought-tolerant and requires no pruning to maintain its neat form.

#### **Double Play Red Spirea**

(Spiraea japonica 'SMNSJMFR') Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This spirea is the closest of all varieties to providing deep red color. The dense mound of dark green foliage starts off with a burgundy hue in the spring and in early summer, It is heavily dappled with clusters of reddish magenta shades of blooms that contrast wonderfully in the landscape. This specimen is drought-tolerant and requires no pruning.

# **Goldmound Spirea**

(Spiraea japonica 'Goldmound') Height & Spread: 3' Full Sun

Vibrant golden spring foliage, accented by clusters of pink flowers, cools to a yellow-green in summer then to a rich, orange-yellow in fall. Its neat, mounding habit requires no pruning to maintain a tidy shape. This specimen is drought-tolerant.

#### Magic Carpet Spirea

(Spiraea japonica 'Magic Carpet') Height & Spread: 1-2' Full Sun

A neat, compact, and mounded shrub with vibrant red new leaves, the Magic Carpet Spirea is truly a wonderful addition to the landscape. Clusters of small pink flowers contrast with bright gold mature foliage that turns rich russet-red in fall. This color combo will brighten any landscape. This spirea is drought-tolerant and requires no pruning.

# **Tor Birchleaf Spirea**

(Spiraea betulifolia 'Tor') Height & Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

The neat mound of rich green foliage of the Tor Birchleaf Spirea provides the ideal backdrop for tight clusters of brilliant white flowers. Foliage becomes hues of gold, red, and purple in autumn. This specimen looks fantastic planted in groups, lining a walkway, or as a foundation plant. It is drought-tolerant and requires no pruning.

# Vanhoutte Renaissance Spirea

(Spiraea x vanhouttei 'Renaissance') Height: 5-8' Spread: 7-10' Full Sun

This spirea is a super-hardy, disease-resistant version of an old-fashioned garden favorite. This shrub creates an elegant spectacle in spring when its graceful fountain of gently arched branches are covered in dainty white flowers. It adds a wonderfully soft texture to the landscape and looks great contrasted with broad-leaved shrubs or evergreens. It is drought-tolerant.

#### **Tiger Eyes Sumac**

(Rhus typhina 'Bailtiger') Height & Spread: 6' Sun/ Part Shade

A beautiful golden-leafed form of the gorgeous Staghorn Sumac, this brilliant specimen adds great contrast to the landscape. New growth is a lively chartreuse green, quickly changing to yellow with both colors contrasting nicely with the rosy-pink leaf stems. Foliage is scarlet-orange in fall. It is fast-growing, pest and disease-free, and drought-tolerant. It may spread aggressively to form thickets.

#### **Staghorn Sumac**

(Rhus typhina var. laciniata) Height: 15-20' Spread: 20-30' Sun/ Part Shade

Prized for its spectacular fall foliage and showy fruits, the Staghorn Sumac is a large shrub with picturesque branches and velvety reddish-brown branchlets. The foliage of large, pinnate, bright-green leaves turns striking shades of orange, yellow and scarlet in fall. Cone-shaped panicles of greenyellow flowers bloom in early to mid-summer. Pollinators are very attracted to the flowers. In winter, the bare twigs resemble the velvety horns of a young stag, hence the common name. Fast-growing, usually pest and disease-free, and drought-tolerant, this shrub may spread aggressively to form extensive thickets.

#### Kalm's St. John's Wort

(Hypericum kalmianum) Height & Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

Compact and easy to grow, Kalm's St. John's Wort is a small semi-evergreen shrub with showy, golden yellow flowers blooming for about 6 weeks in mid to late summer. They emerge in flat clusters at the tips of upright branching stems. Each cup-shaped flower presents petals surrounding a tuft of golden stamens. Rich in nectar, they are a favorite of pollinators. The dark blue-green leaves provides a lovely backdrop for the golden blossoms.

# Alfredo Compact Viburnum

(Viburnum trilobum 'Alfredo') Height & Spread: 4-6' Sun/ Part Shade

This quick-covering, low hedge is valued for its brilliant display of edible, bright red fall berries. It has dark green deciduous foliage which emerges brick red in spring. The serrated lobed leaves turn an outstanding red in the fall. Attractive white lacecap flowers on its compact, upright form make this a beautifully elegant specimen.

#### Autumn Jazz Viburnum

(Viburnum dentatum 'Ralph Senior') Height: 6-10' Spread: 8-12' Sun/ Part Shade

Enjoy three seasons of vibrant interest in the landscape with the Autumn Jazz Arrowwood Viburnum. It is a vase-shaped shrub with creamy-white flowers blooming from late-May to mid-June. The flower clutsters are very attractive to pollinators and create pleasing contrast against the foliage. The summer foliage is crisp and dark-green, transforming into gorgeous fall hues of yellow, orange, and burgundy – which can vary in intensity. This viburnum then produces clusters of blue-black berries, and the fruit is highly sought after by songbirds.

#### Blue Muffin Viburnum

(Viburnum dentatum 'Blue Muffin') Height & Spread: 5-7' Sun/ Part Shade

This compact beauty produces an abundance of creamy white spring flowers and rich blue berries in late summer. Shiny green leaves turn marvelous shades of purple-red and gold in fall. It is excellent for planting in groupings, masses, and as a filler in the shrub border.

#### Brandywine Viburnum

(Viburnum nudum 'Bulk') Height & Spread: 5-7' Sun/ Part Shade

The Brandywine Viburnum delivers loads of breathtaking berries that transform from green to shades of vivid pink and blue. Showy and glossy leaves change to incredible dark maroon-red in autumn. Its moderate size is great for a showy, medium size hedge.

#### **Chicago Lustre Viburnum**

(Viburnum dentatum 'Synnestvedt') Height: 10-12' Spread: 8-10' Sun/ Part Shade

A handsome, upright, and rounded shrub with arching branches, the Chicago Lustre Viburnum is an absolute favorite. Rich dark green foliage turns yellow/red tones in autumn. It produces clusters of tiny white flowers followed by blue-black fruit. This shrub is greatly enjoyed by pollinators and other forms of wildlife. Use as a tall screen, hedge or specimen.

# Doublefile Viburnum

(Viburnum plicatum tomentosum 'Mariesii') Height: 10-12' Spread: 12-15' Sun/ Part Shade

The broadly rounded form on this medium-sized shrub supports tiered horizontal branches that display the magnificent, large, white, lacecap flower clusters. Creating a stunning show in spring, the elegant flowers add a delicate effect to the landscape and are attractive to pollinators. The pleated, green foliage develops vivid red fall color. The red fruit in fall is very ornamental and attractive to wildlife.

#### **Raspberry Tart Viburnum**

(Viburnum dentatum 'Rastzam') Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This viburnum grows up to 5 feet tall and wide, about half the size of other cultivars. Its upright and compact growth habit makes it rela- tively low maintenance. Enjoy their creamy white flowers in the late spring and small blue-black berries in early-late fall as pollinators and birds also enjoy them. Dark green foliage turns a gorgeous burgundy color in the fall, creating excellent contrast. This variety of viburnum is tough and highly adaptable.

#### Sugar and Spice Viburnum

(Viburnum carlesii 'JN-Select S') Height & Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

A heavy flowering cultivar with the same sweet-spiced, floral fragrance for which the species is known, the Sugar and Spice Viburnum is a wonderfully sweet addition to the landscape. The flower clusters are smaller than average, but are much more plentiful throughout the plant. In fall, the glossy green foliage turns a showy red.

# Midnight Sun Weigela

Weigela florida 'Verweig9' Height & Spread: 1-1.5' Full Sun

This vibrant Weigela is tiny but mighty! Pink flowers invite pollinators in late spring. New foliage emerges bright green before maturing into warm red and orange hues. By late summer, this shrub is set ablaze in brilliant oranges and reds. This deer-resistant specimen is very low-maintenance.

#### Spice Baby Viburnum

Viburnum carlesii 'SMVB' Height & Spread: 3.5-5' Sun/ Part Shade

This space-saving Korean Spice Viburnum puts on a lovely display, year after year. Airy white and pink blooms cover this shrub in early spring, giving off a delightful fragrance and inviting pollinators. Dark green, deer-resistant foliage turns marvelous red in fall. This durable specimen is great for low hedges.

#### **Opening Day Doublefile Viburnum**

Viburnum plicatum 'PIIVIB-II' Height & Spread: 6-8' Sun/ Part Shade

Dark green foliage covers the rounded structure of this shrub, turning a stunning shade of burgundy in fall. An explosion of white blooms occurs in late spring, producing baseball-sized clusters. Red berries follow these blooms and mature to black, attracting various wildlife.

# Fine Wine Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Bramwell') Height: 3-4' Spread: 3' Sun/Part Sun

This Weigela selection has a tight and upright form. Rich, dark foliage color is similar in color to that of fine burgundy wine, providing vibrant contrast to the deep pink spring flowers. This adaptable shrub is excellent for planting in groups or as a border.

# Midnight Wine Shine Weigela

(Weigela florida 'SMNWFMS') Height: 12"-18" Spread: 2-3' Full Sun

This is an improved selection with darker, extremely glossy foliage. It has excellent hardiness and is less prone to tip dieback. Foliage of this gorgeous petite shrub is a deep purple, nearly black, color that almost outshines the bright pink trumpet shaped flowers. This adaptable shrub is excellent for planting in groups or as a border.

#### My Monet Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Verweig') Height: 1-2' Spread: 2' Sun/ Part Shade

As the first dwarf variegated weigela to be introduced, its tight habit and colorful foliage make it very versatile. Possible applications include an artistic drift along the edge of an annual or perennial bed or as an accent piece in a container.

#### Very Fine Wine Weigela

Weigela florida 'SMNWFDFPD' Height & Width: 2-2.5' Full Sun

This tough shrub is highly adaptable and easy to care for. It is highly deer-resistant, yet highly adored by hummingbirds. Its darkened foliage and profuse pink blooms are improved from the 'Fine Wine' Weigela. It can be planted in almost any sunny site.

#### **Bubbly Wine Weigela**

Weigela florida 'Floraclar' Height and Spread: 2-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This eye-catching Weigela offers so much colorful detail with its bright yellow and green variegated foliage. Pale purple blooms arrive in late spring and compliment the burgundy stems. This shrub attracts pollinators and is deer-resistant.

# Czechmark Trilogy Weigela

Weigela florida 'VUKOZ Gemini' Height & Spread: 3-3.5' Sun/ Part Shade

This unique Weigela showcases three bloom colors at once. Emerging in late spring, enjoy pink, white, and red flowers. Its glossy green foliage looks charming all season long. This low effort shrub is deer-resistant and highly adored by pollinators. Hummingbirds love this plant.

#### My Monet Purple Effect Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Verweig8') Height & Spread: 18"-3' Sun/ Part Shade

This weigela offers new color, more flowers, and better adaptability, while sharing all the charm and beauty of the original My Monet Weigela. Its variegated cream and mint green foliage takes on purple tones and it is much more able to withstand the rigors of colder climates. Though it is slightly larger, it can be used in much the same way as other varieties, such as a colorful edging, in a container, or anywhere you need a spot of clear, clean color.

#### Shining Sensation Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Bokrashine') Height: 5-6' Spread: 3-4' Full Sun

The Shining Sensation Weigela provides your landscape with spectacular contrast in one pretty package. Each spring, hot pink trumpet-shaped flowers emerge and are plentiful. They contrast beautifully against the backdrop of deep red to maroon leaves. The dark leaves are shiny, adding to the texture of the landscape. Birds and butterflies adore this specimen.

#### Sonic Bloom Pink Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Bolrasopin') Height & Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

The Sonic Bloom Pink Weigela is a wonderful accent that adds a pop of attractive color to the landscape. Hot pink flowers emerge in May and continue to bloom until frost while contrasting against the rich green foliage. It is an alluring choice for shrub borders, mixed borders, and foundation plantings. You will love watching the butterflies that are drawn to this bright shrub.

#### Sonic Bloom Red Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Verweig6') Height & Spread: 4-6' Full Sun

This continuously blooming shrub produces stunning red blossoms that draw hummingbirds until frost and make a gorgeous statement in shrub borders. Flowers create gorgeous contrast against rich green foliage. Easy to care for, you can enjoy the repeated blossoms without ever having to deadhead. Pollinators adore this shrub.

# Spilled Wine Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Bokraspiwi') Height & Spread: 2-3' Full Sun

Dark red, wavy leaves are a spectacular feature on this weigela. It has an attractive, spreading habit. Hot pink-magenta flowers contrast against the dark foliage and are very attractive to pollinators.

#### Stunner Weigela

(Weigela x 'Spring2') Height & Spread: 3-4' Sun/ Part Shade

This hardy plant features vibrant pink blooms that pop against sleek dark purple foliage, creating a showy, elegant look. The intriguing dark foliage grows in a shapely mound and stands out in the landscape even when not in bloom to provide some lovely foliage interest to the landscape.

# Wine and Roses Weigela

(Weigela florida 'Alexandra') Height & Spread: 4-5' Sun/ Part Shade

Rosy-pink flowers displayed against the dark purple, glossy foliage of this weigela are a marvelous accent in the landscape. The foliage is much darker than that of older varieties, contrasting beautifully with the elegant flowers. Pollinators adore this shrub.

#### Nishiki Dappled Willow

(Salix integra 'Hakuro Nishiki') Height & Spread: 15-20' Sun/ Part Shade

Attracting the eye with its bright, showy colors, the Dappled Willow is a deciduous shrub or small tree of great beauty. Luminous variegated foliage on graceful branches are adored throughout the growing season. Emerging pink in spring, the narrow, lanceshaped leaves gradually mature to variegated shades of pink, creamy-white and green, before fading to green as the summer progresses. In the fall, the leaves eventually turn yellow before shedding to the ground, revealing coral red stems to enjoy in winter. In the colder regions, only the new growth will turn coral red. The entire length of the branches will turn coral red in warmer climates.
